In accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21 (11) and (12) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

Restore signage and lighting to prior condition by no later than July 31.

Mounting posts shall be drilled into mortar joints only and not into the face of any brick or stone. Any surface-mounted electrical conduit shall be painted to match surrounding building material.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 








North & West Elevation Existing Signage




29522 CNN GRILL RICHARD PURVIS JAMIE PETERSON BUILDING SIGN






