Minor Modification to a Detailed Planned Development known as Honey Creek Corporate Center, Phase 1 at 125 S. 84th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53214; File No. 200133

The Honey Creek Corporate Center General Planned Development (GPD) was established in 1989 as File Number 881840 and has subsequently been modified. A Detailed Planned Development (DPD) for Honey Creek Corporate Center, Phase 1 was approved in 1997 as File Number 961722 (permitting an office building with one building wall sign), and was modified in 1999 as File Number 991275 to allow a taller building identification sign.

Greywolf Partners, Inc., as the management agent for Honey Creek Corporate Center, Phase 1 is hereby requesting the following minor modifications to the Detailed Planned Development at 125 S. 84th Street:

- Up to three building wall signs (one per story) on the south side of the building only. Currently only one building wall sign is permitted.
- These signs have the restriction of being 30 inches in height
- The signs shall consist of individual letters
- A logo may be taller provided that it does not go outside the brown precast sign band area
- Signage will be centered on the south side of the building between the precast bands
- Signage will be installed by a verified signage company
- Tenants may have the option to make these signs internally illuminated
- Slight modifications to these standards based on tenant needs may be reviewed and approved by City staff on a case by case basis

All other aspects of the DPD zoning will remain unchanged.


