Dear Alderman Bauman:

This is in response to a request on behalf of MGIC located at 250 East Kilbourn Avenue to install the above-captioned parking restriction to improve visibility for motorists exiting the driveway from their underground parking garage on State Street due to the conversion of the one-way traffic control on East State Street to a two-way operation.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that parked vehicles obstruct the view of on-coming east bound vehicles on East State Street making it difficult for motorists to exit the driveway from their underground parking garage. We, therefore, in the interest of public safety, recommend the above-captioned traffic parking change.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
