Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. Hi Nik,

It's time for our multi-annual update on Little Caesar's. I'd assume we're nearing the time when they are due for license renewal, so I'm also hoping you can let me know when that is happening. As you might guess, both Roxy and I are working from home now, so this is particularly disruptive now. Here are a couple somewhat recent developments:

I'm attaching a couple of pictures I took this morning. The trash can in the picture has not been emptied in weeks, and once again trash is accumulating outside their dumpsters. Perhaps not surprisingly, this corresponds with the return of skunks and raccoons nightly in my yard. Additionally, we find Little Caesar's trash in our yard on a daily basis through some combination of littering, wind, and rodents.

I'm also providing a couple links to short videos that demonstrate our other main concern at this point, the excessive bass coming from car stereos which, as you'll hear in the videos, rattles our entire house several times a day. We've tried calling the store directly, but have never seen an employee actually respond by going out into the parking lot. We've tried speaking with people directly, but it happens too frequently for us to manage and has resulted in a couple verbal threats. We've also called the non-emergency line to report this, but by the time the police did respond, the vehicle had left, and I was told this was "something you gotta live with" instead of something that Little Caesar's had to change. On another note, while on the surface it appears there have been improvements to the property over the last year, they have been done to such poor quality, and without regard for neighbors, that they actually make things worse for us. I don't believe the new parking lot or fence are actually compliant with the residential and street screening requirements. The fence also has no sound dampening effect, which I had discussed with management prior to installation. The parking lot was completely re-paved last year, which I believe should have triggered the new landscape requirements. The new lighting is incredibly bright and oriented such that it illuminates my living and dining room to a really annoying degree.


I'm wondering if you might have a contact to pass along from the BID. I'd love to see if they have any of the same concerns as I do.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 6/18/2020 at 10:50 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


