This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 11/30/18 at 12:25am, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check for underage patrons at 1832 E. North Avenue (Vitucci's). The tavern passed the compliance check.
- 2. On 12/15/19 at 2:30am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1832 E. North Avenue for a battery complaint. Officers interviewed the caller who stated that the staff at the tavern threw his drink on the ground and threw him to the ground multiple times. Officers interviewed an employee (Angelo M VITUCCI) who stated that the caller was disturbing two females at the bar and was asked multiple times to leave the females alone. When the caller refused, the bartender asked the caller to leave and took his drink. The caller grabbed another patrons' cocktail and a napkin holder and threw it at the bartender. The caller was then escorted outside the tavern. The caller attempted to gain access back into the bar and was pushed by VITUCCI. The video shows the caller stumble backwards to the ground but doesn't show who pushed him. There was video surveillance of the incident and it inventoried.
- 3. On 01/17/19, Milwaukee Police conducted a capacity check at 1832 E. North Avenue. Investigation revealed that the tavern was 57 patrons over capacity. The establishment's capacity is 160. When Police entered the establishment, they were met by the acting manager, Angelo M VITUCCI who stated that he had an employee meeting before the tavern was open and told his staff to keep count of patrons, so he thought they were below capacity for the evening. While interviewing the acting manager, officers observed an intoxicated subject inside the tavern after hours wearing a pink wrist band which indicated that he was a patron.

VITUCCI said that he was an employee but had "clocked out" at 10:30 and did not know he was not supposed to be in the establishment. The patron was cited and acting manager, VITUCCI, was told the agent would be receiving a citation.

- 4. On 01/22/19 at 8:19pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1832 E. North Avenue for a battery complaint. Video Surveillance revealed that two patrons (KRIMMER and BUGGY) were involved in a physical altercation inside the establishment and an off duty employee (MUNS) broke up the skirmish. During the fight, officers observed, on video, what appeared to be a firearm in KRIMMERs' back waistband. Shortly after the fight was stopped by MUNS, and before police arrive, video shows MUNS, KRIMMER, and another employee quickly get up from the bar and walk out of camera view, returning a short time later. KRIMMER and MUNS were asked about the firearm and they said they did not see one. The manager, Angelo VITUCCI, showed KRIMMER the surveillance footage before police arrival and told officers that he has a "no firearm" policy inside his establishment. The manager, VITUCCI, believed KRIMMER had a firearm during the altercation. Buggy consented to a PBT which resulted in a .34 reading. KRIMMER and BUGGY were mailed Disorderly Conduct citations.
- 5. On 02/07/19 at 4:00pm, a meeting was held at the First District Police Station in regards to item #3. Present at the meeting was Officer MICHALAK, Sergeant GAUERKE, Assistant District Attorney, Assistant City Attorney, Agent Julie VITUCCI, Angelo VITUCCI, and an attorney for the agent. Angelo stated he took extra security measures that night to make sure that they did not go over capacity. VITUCCI's lawyer stated he had video proof they were not over capacity and would present that to the City Attorney. Both Julie and Angelo were professional and courteous during the meeting.
- 6. On 03/28/19 at 11:41pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1832 E. North Avenue for a noise complaint. Officers interviewed the manager, Angelo VITUCCI, who was outside the establishment and stated he did not have any exterior speakers that were playing music, but the front entrance door was propped open. He was informed per City Ordinances the doors to the tavern must remain closed after 10pm and exterior music must be turned off on the weekdays at 10pm. Angelo said that he was not aware of these "rules" and would close the door. Angelo was informed by officers that this was not the first call for this type of complaint and if it continues, he would receive a citation.
- 7. On 04/04/19 at 11:01pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1832 E. North Avenue for a noise complaint. Upon arrival, officers could hear the music coming from the patio speakers from approximately a half block away. The manager, Angelo VITUCCI, was asked to turn the music off and he complied. Angelo, in the recent past, was warned multiple times about having music playing after 10pm and was told by officers that the agent would be issued a citation for tonight's violation. At 12:07am, Milwaukee Police received another complaint of loud music coming from the patio at 1832 E. North Avenue. Milwaukee Police returned to the scene and found that the music was, again, playing from the patio speakers. Again, Angelo was told to turn off the patio speaker and, again, he complied.

8. On 04/19/19, Milwaukee Police conducted follow-up on a complaint that an underage employee consumed alcohol at the tavern located at 1832 E. North Avenue. Officers confirmed that the underage employee was admitted to St. Mary's Hospital with the blood alcohol level of .394. Officers went to 1832 E. North Avenue (Vitucci's) and interviewed the manager Angelo M. VITUCCI. Angelo showed officers surveillance video which showed that at 1:47am, the underage employee was sitting at the bar with a drink in her hand and the bartender poured her a shot of alcohol (which she then drank). The bartender, who poured the underage employee a shot, said that the underage employee could not walk to her friend's car, so he picked her up and carried her to the car. The bartender thought that the friend who picked up the underage employee was her roommate.

- 9. On 06/13/2019 officers, along with agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av. The officers found 18 bottles of liquor contaminated. The applicant was not able to produce invoices for all of the liquor on the premise. She was advised to dispose of the contaminated alcohol and deface the bottles.
- 10. On 08/29/2019 at 11:12pm officers were dispatched to Trouble with Subject at Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av. The complaint was of a female being disorderly after being denied entry by the bounce. While enroute there was an additional call at the same location for Noise Nuisance. The officers spoke with the manager, Angelo VITUCCI, who stated he would keep the door closed and have security at the door at all times. On 08/30/2019 at 12:20 another call for a Noise Nuisance was received. When the officer arrived he observed the front door propped open, with no security in sight. The officer talked with Angelo VITUCCI and advised him a tavern report would be filed.
- 11. On 09/19/2019 at 12:24am officers were dispatched to Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av, for a battery complaint. The investigation revealed a patron became upset when he was denied entry and spit in the face of the manager, Angelo VITUCCI, which resulted in a physical altercation. Neither party wanted to press charges. The officers check the video surveillance but it did not show the altercation.

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This report is written by PO Molly PLUMLEY, assigned to District One, Late Power shift.

On Thursday, June 13, 2019 while assigned to squad #1442 with PO Eric NORTHWOOD and PO James DUERR, we conducted a tavern check with agent Georgeann KING ( Alcohol & Tobacco Enforcement Unit) at 1832 E. North Av. (Vituccis).

During the inspection we observed 18 bottles of alcohol that were contaminated behind the rear and front bar of the tavern. Agent KING informed VITUCCI, Julie A (W/M 4/23/1960) that the bottles needed to be emptied and the bottles needed to be defaced. It should also be noted that Julie could not produce all the invoices for the liquor that was on the premises. Angelo also turned over a stack of approximately 30 fake ID's to us that will be used for underage/ fake ID training in the future. Agent KING informed them that she would be returning to conduct another inspection of the tavern before 10/30/2019.

## INITIAL INVESTIGATION

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This report was written by P.O. Kristopher SARDINA, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift, Code Red Deployment. Code RED is an initiative that is aimed at maintaining order in Milwaukee's nighttime entertainment districts. This initiative incorporates law enforcement, city agencies, local business owners and community members in a collective crime prevention task force.

On Thursday August 29, 2019 at approximately 11:12 P.M. Squad 1430 responded to a trouble with subject complaint at 1832 E. North Avenue, Vitucci Cocktail Lounge. The disturbance occurred due to security refusing entrance of a female to the establishment.

During Squad 1430's transit, a second call for service was entered for the same location for a noise nuisance.

Upon arrival I spoke with the manager, later identified as **Angelo M. VITUCCI (w/m, 10-09-96)**. VITUCCI stated he was going to keep the front door closed and have security personnel at the door at all times.

On Friday August 30, 2019 at approximately 12:12 A.M. Squad 1430 received another call for service at the same location for the same reason, noise nuisance. Upon arrival I observed the front door propped open again with no security personnel in sight. Upon entrance to the establishment I spoke with Angelo M. VITUCCI again and informed him a tavern report would be filled.

#### INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by PO Brian WUNDER assigned to District One, late Power Shift.

On Thursday 9-19-2019 at approximately 12:24am, numerous squads including PO James DUERR and I (Squad 1442) responded to 1832 E North Ave (VITUCCIS COCKTAIL LOUNGE), which is in the City and County of Milwaukee, in regards to a battery call service.

The investigation revealed a patron had attempted to gain entry into the tavern, but was denied by both the security personnel and the on-scene manager, Angelo VITUCCI. The subject then spat on Angelo VITUCCI, which resulted in a physical alternation between the subject and Angelo. Neither party involved wanted to pursue any prosecution, and both parties were released on their own recognizance.

It should be noted Angelo VITUCCI was highly intoxicated and did not allow his posted security personnel, who was sober, ample time to deescalate and/or resolve the situation before stepping in. Angelo did attempt to review CCTV footage of the incident with PO DUERR and I, however no viable camera angle captured the incident.



The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 6/23/2020 at 9:00 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
