Dear Mr. Kovak,

Over the years the Hot Spot Supermarket (HSS) located at 2643 W Atkinson Ave has come before the City of Milwaukee Licenses Committee numerous times whom have heard objections to renewing its Class A Malt & Class A Liquor License by countless community members. Community members have testified to illegal activity such as drug trafficking, prostitution, shootings, illegal parking, loitering, littering, and the overall poisonous, toxic, and dangerous environment that the HSS has contributed to in their community (See Appendix 1: (Video on Flash Drive: Hot Spot Sup Mark 2017 Lic Renew Hearing- Ms. Green begging for help) Although the HSS Class A Malt & Class A Liquor License has been suspended in the past somehow it was reinstated and the poisonous, toxic and dangerous environment remains in our community.

At the Licensing Committee Hearing held on January 4, 2017 for the Class A Malt & Class A Liquor and Food Dealer License Renewal Application for "HOT SPOT SUPERMARKET" at 2643 W ATKSINSON AVE, based on the police report and neighborhood testimony ("for and against" renewal) the committee voted unanimously not to renew. The community members whom give their testimony left the hearing with the understanding the license was not renewed as per the unanimous vote (See Appendix: 2: Video on Flash Drive: Hot Spot Sup Mark 2017 Lic Renew Hearing, 2) that was taken in their presence by the Licensing Committee. However, the motion made by ALD ZIELINSKI to the Common Council was only a 30 day suspension which was approved by the Gommon Council (See Appendix 2.1): Zielinski Recommendation to Common Council). No community members were provided the opportunity to file an Objection for consideration by the Common Council.

For the 2019 License Committee review of the renewal of HSS's Malt & Liquor license apparently no notices were sent to community members whom objected in the past so no one showed up at the hearing on June 25, 2019. In addition, many of the community members whom did testify in 2017 have completely lost faith in the system and do not intent to participate because they believe the system is corrupt and broken. However, in reviewing the Police's and the HSS Security Guard's testimony from the June 25, 2019 hearing it's clear the environment in and around the HSS remains poisonous, toxic and dangerous.

It has come to my attention that the HSS's Retail, Tobacco, and Malt & Liquor license application uses the address 2643 W Atkinson Avenue (See Appendix: 3:) which is not in the city of Milwaukee Assessors Real Estate Addresses data base (Confirmed by Assessors Office and Office of the City Treasurer) and does not have a corresponding tax key identification number. The correct address for the parcel in which HSS is located in the city of Milwaukee Assessor's real estate data base is 4360 – 4362 N 27th Street (See Appendix: 4:). As such the licenses for HSS are not associated with a valid address with a corresponding tax key number and should be relssued under the correct address.

To ensure the communities objections are taken into consideration and duly for the record I hereby submit the following objections to reissuing Hot Spot Supermarket located at 4360 – 4362 N 27th Street a Class A Malt & Class A Liquor License on the following grounds:

- Objection 1: Crime, disorder, loitering and antisocial behavior

 Countless members of the community have provided credible testimony as to the drugs, prostitution, public drinking & intoxication, loitering, and overall unhealthy antisocial behavior that tends to gravitate to-in-and-around the HSS. The testimony can be corroborated by MPD police reports and testimony from Officers whom work that neighborhood. Evidence can be observed in front of the Hot Spot practically every day of the week (See Appendix 5).
- Objection 2: Inappropriate building design and surrounding street infrastructure:

 The building was originally designed to accommodate 6 apartments in the upper level and 5 small commercial business in the lower level each with their own address which were primarily frequented by walk-up neighborhood customers. The HSS has expanded over time taking over the entire lower level which has overgrown the capacity for which the property and surrounding street infrastructure was designed. It no longer has adequate access for its high volume of customers and the associated traffic.
- Objection 3: Inadequate parking and dangerous traffic congestion conditions:

The HSS is located on the southeast corner of 27th Street & Atkinson does not have a parking lot which should be required for a business of this type, size and associated car traffic as well as vendor deliveries. To compound the problem 27th & Atkinson is a complicated 3 street intersection with 5 lanes on 27th St, 4 lanes on Atkinson and 4 more lanes that feed into W Congress Street. There is a bus stop in front so there is no parking on 27th St and there is very limited parking on Atkinson Ave because there is a bus stop and driveway on the north side of the street. Cars park on the south side of Atkinson and across the street in the alley and driveway areas. With people opening their car doors and exiting their cars directly onto Atkinson the traffic slows to a crawl and often to a complete stop while pedestrians clear from the street to enter the HSS. (See Appendix 5). Garden Homes Park is just around the corner which is an extremely dangerous area with a very high crime rate and with numerous dangerous people that gravitate towards the intersection of 27th & Atkinson where the HSS is located. This makes for an extremely dangerous situation for people that get stuck in traffic at that intersection where there is a high occurrence of gun shots that are reported and can be confirmed by MPD.

Objection 4: Litter

Although efforts have been made by the HSS to keep the immediate area in front of the supermarket clean you don't have to go far to see the profuse amount of litter scattered on the sidewalks, along the curb, and on the lawns of neighbors in every direction. The HSS should have the responsibility to clean-up trash associated with their business in at least a one block radius in every direction. (See Recommendation: 1).

Objection 5: Ownership Transfers

4360 — 4362 N 27th St is also the address the city of Milwaukee Assessors office has recorded very irregular ownership exchanges dating back to 1992 with repeated Buyers & Sellers by a Mr. Norman Ammerman, Salem Nader A and Hot Spots Investments LLC (See Appendix: 6). I recommend a thorough Investigation of the ownership transfers be completed before any new licenses are issued to this address.



Appendix 2 Video on Flash Drive: 2017 Licensing Committee hearing and committee vote to not renew







Note the driver exiting in the parked car just to the left of HSS causing the turning car to swing wide towards the oncoming lane.



RECCOMMENDATIONS

Recommendation 1:

As part of the Licensing Application for Retail, Tabaco and Liquor the applicant should sign a Litter Management Plan that states the business owner will be responsible to clean up litter twice per day within a one block radius of their business. This should apply for all businesses such as Supermarkets, Drug Stores selling retail (like Walgreens), Convenience Stores, and Gas Stations selling retail items. Some businesses like McDonald's have this type of program formally written in their daily maintenance schedule to clean up all litter within a one block radius of the restaurant.



Re: Report of the Renewal Application of Nael N. Jabbar for Class "A" Malt and Class "A" Liquor licenses for the premises located at 2643 West Arkinson Avenue in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("HOT SPOT SUPERMARKET").

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Nael N. Jabbar (hereinafter the "Licensee") is the holder of a Class "A" Malt and Class "A" Liquor licenses for the premises located at 2643 West Atkinson Avenue in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("HOT SPOT SUPERMARKET"). Said licenses expired at midnight, February 6, 2017.
- 2. An application to renew said licenses was filed with the Office of the City Clerk on October 31, 2016.
- 3. Pursuant to Chapter 85 and 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the matter was referred to the Milwaukee Police Department for investigation.
- 4. On July 5, 2017, the City Clerk's Office provided notice of a second hearing to the Licensee pursuant to Chapters 85 and 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes of the police report and neighborhood objections and included a copy of the police report. The matter was scheduled for a second hearing pursuant to an order in Milwaukee County Case 2017CV000691 on the police report and neighborhood objections on July 18, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 301B of the third floor of City Hall. At said date, time and place the licensee did appear and was represented by counsel, Attorney Jeffrey Guerard.
- 5. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following additional facts:



- Á Atty. Jeffrey Guerard stated that the Licensee has hired additional security guards, and addressed loitering issues by filing injunctions against perpetrators. Licensee stated that the injunctions the Licensee is filing are to help alleviate the loitering issues, and three injunctions have been filed to date. The Licensee expects to file more injunctions against additional people. He stated that the injunctions are filed to prohibit the return of violators who are involved in drug dealing, or have threatened the life of the Licensee. He stated that the Licensee has installed 49 security cameras to improve surveillance and the feeds from those cameras can be viewed by phone at any time. In response to a question from Alderwoman Coggs, the Licensee explained that the police were provided access to the camera feed after the January Committee. The Licensee explained that the additional cameras and police access have led to the arrest of numerous problem subjects in the area, even some who were not directly causing problems at Hot Spot. The Licensee stated that those that are in support live in close proximity of the premises. The Licensee stated that he also plans to change the name of the business in order to rebrand. Ald. Lewis asked that Licensee if they report the loitering and suggested monitoring cameras during the early morning hours.
- В. Pres. Hamilton stated that there have been several community meetings since the last meeting on the expectations from the neighborhood. He stated that there have been some improvements and some of the issues faced in the neighborhood are occurring throughout the city. Pres. Hamilton explained that the police have been at some of his community meetings and stated that they did not want to close the business. He stated that the Licensee is a part of the community and attended several community meetings. He stated that those closest to the premises are the ones that have direct testimony on what actually takes place at and around the establishment and appropriate weight should be given to that testimony. He stated that he has reviewed videos from the business, visited the neighborhood, and witnessed significant improvement. He stated that the Licensee has hired an outreach coordinator to assist with community relations. He stated that it is cleaner, the neighborhood is working together, and there is a relationship with the police. He stated that it should be considered that the Licensee provides and help the neighborhood with obtaining jobs. He recommended a suspension of 30 days.

Individuals present in opposition:

C. Janell Elder-Green, 4333 North 29th Street, stated that she has witnessed drastic changes in the neighborhood and is afraid for the children that are in the area. She stated that there is fighting, loitering, and drug dealing that occur on and around the premises. She is in opposition and has not noticed any improvements with the last incident witnessed occurring on May 24th. She stated that she did not know if those fighting were patrons of the premises, or if the fight began in front of the Hot Spot. In response to a question from Ald. Rainey, Ms. Elder-Green explained that she believed the owner was breaking up the fight outside of the establishment. She stated that she never met the Licensee, he recently began to be nice to her and she wished he would have tried months before now. She stated that the premise adds to the destruction of the neighborhood. Ald. Zielinski asked Ms. Green if she has noticed any changes since the installation of

additional security cameras. He asked the Licensee if he has the fight on camera. The Licensee stated that he was not present during the above described altercation and Ms. Elder-Green may be confusing him with someone else.

- D. Ald. Zielinski also explained that the reason the business has continued to operate in spite of the earlier decision by the Committee and the full Council is because a court issued a temporary injunction.
- E. Vince Tony, 2721 West Roosevelt Drive, stated he was told by the Licensee that things were going to improve and that has not happened. He stated that he has witnessed loitering on several occasions and on one occasion noticed the security guard appeared to be loitering with three other people. He stated that the area is dangerous, the premise is a hazard to the neighborhood, and he is in opposition. He asked Mr. Tony if he's attended any safety meetings in the last year and what time did he witness the loitering on Sunday. In response, the Licensee stated that he tried to give Mr. Tony, but Mr. Tony would not accept the number and refused to talk to him.
- F. Sharon Price, 4329 North 29th Street, stated that the neighborhood is deteriorating. She stated that she has witnessed loitering every morning from the premises to the park across the street. She further explained that thee street is often blocked by cars stopping in front of the premises. She stated that there are trash and drug dealings in front of the store, inside cars. She reported the incidents to the police and alderman. In response to a question from Ald. Rainey, she clarified that she was unable to be certain that the drug dealing in cars was specifically related to Hot Spot. She stated that even as early as 7 a.m., there are approximately 15 people around the premises, but she is not sure what time the store opens. She believes the store has become a magnet for drug dealing.

Individuals present in support:

- G. Martha Freeman, 4388 North 27th Street, stated that the Licensee is willing to work with the neighborhood and she is in support. She stated that the premises are not the issue, the community is trying to work with the young men that are causing issues in the neighborhood, and the issues occur throughout the neighborhood. She stated that there are cleanup crews to clean the street daily.
- H. Sean Moore, 4381 North 26th Street, stated that the neighbors were asked to get involved and he is in support. He stated that there is loitering, but it is not associated with this premises. He stated that he previously testified in opposition, but has witnessed a great improvement. He stated that he believes that if the Licensee continues his improvements the neighborhood can change for the better, if the neighbors are strong on expectations of the Licensee. He stated that he is the Chairperson for Community Outreach Engagement and takes the community issues to the owners to come up with viable solutions.
- Felicia Ferguson, 4392 North 27th Street, stated that she is in support and the Licensee is a great contributor to the neighborhood. She stated that she

- job opportunities at the premises for those in the community. She stated that she has not witnessed any loitering while she has been employed.
 - J. Jimmy Wilkins, 2511 West Atkinson Avenue, stated that the Licensee has made improvements and he is in support.
 - K. Jessica Allen, 1946 North 39th Street, stated that she works at the premises and is in support. She stated that the Licensee works with her in scheduling her employment around the care of her child.
 - L. Maria Gomez, 2225 North 34th Street, stated that she is employed by the Licensee, witnessed improvements, and is in support.
 - M. James Tate, 2434 West Roosevelt Drive, stated he is in support.
 - N. James Cocroft, 2615 West Atkinson Avenue, stated there is improvement and he is in support. He stated that the loitering is at the park and a vacant house in the neighborhood. He stated that the Licensec cleans the neighborhood regularly.
 - O. Lashonda Jordan, 2609 West Roosevelt Drive, stated that she has seen improvement and is in support.
 - P. Joe Bova, 4468 North 26th Street, stated that he is in support. He stated that the improvements in the last six months are outstanding and has not noticed any loitering in relation to the premises. He stated that there is no evidence that shows that there are any issues at the premises.
 - Q. Dorice Carter, 3150 North 46th Street, stated that he is head of security at the premises, there is no loitering outside of the premises, and he is in support. He stated that he is armed, bonded, and certified through the State of Wisconsin.
 - R. John Lee, 4396 North 27th Street, stated that he is in support.
 - S. Ald. Lewis asked Ms. Ferguson if she's witnessed loitering during her 60 months of employment at the premises.
 - T. Ald. Coggs asked the Licensee if he told Mr. Tony not to show up to the renewal hearing if he refused take his phone number. She asked the Licensee about his years of ownership, if he was aware of the issues raised by neighbors at the January hearing, and what delayed the response to the issues. She stated that she wonders is there a sincere commitment to addressing the issues and how will he address the issues with those neighbors in opposition. She stated that the importance is not to gain the appreciation of the neighborhood but to improve the neighborhood.
 - U. Ald. Coggs moved to amend the Plan of Operation that the Outreach Coordinator remains intact to work with the community.
 - V. Ald. Zielinski moved approval of the amended application with a 10 day suspension based on the police report and neighborhood testimony. The

motion failed.

W. Ald. Zielinski moved approval with a 30 day suspension of the amended application based on the police report and neighborhood testimony. The motion passed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provided Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes and Chapters 85 and 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
- 2. Based upon the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the Licensee, Nael N. Jabbar who holds a Class "A" Malt and Class "A" Liquor license for the premise located at 2643 West Atkinson Avenue in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("HOT SPOT SUPERMARKET") has not met the criteria of Chapters 85 and 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances to renew the Class "A" Malt and Class "A" Liquor licenses without the issuance of a 30-day suspension. The Committee finds the police report and neighborhood objections as stated above to be true. The Committee based the suspension on the police report and neighborhood testimony.
- 3. 

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 01/29/11 at 4:12 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 27th and Atkinson for a Shots Fired complaint. Police spoke with a victim who stated he was shot by an employee of Hot Spot Super Market. The victim stated it occurred in front of the store and he was then transported by MFD to an area hospital for treatment. Police responded to the store and attempted to speak with the employees and witnesses however they were uncooperative. Police requested to view video. The owner, Nael Jabber, stated that they had no video in the store for at least the last two months. Employees were telling officers they did not know why police were there. The business was closed until the investigation was completed. While on scene, police recovered two guns that were located in the store, which were confiscated by police. Police took photos of all employees, which were shown to the victim who identified Nader Ahmed Salem as the man who shot him. Salem was then placed into custody. Numerous other violations were observed in the store such as the sale of single cigarettes and batteries. Police also found two cans of pepper spray, a knife with a 5 inch blade, an empty gun holster and a scale.
- 2. On 05/24/11 at 12:45 pm, Milwaukee police as well as members from the the Department of Neighnborhood Services conducted a License Premise check at 2643 W Atkinson. A check was done to verify that the store had their camera system properly running. The camera system was found to be not working because of construction work being done on the rear of the building and officers also observed excessive signage on the exterior of the building. The DNS inspector advised Nael Jabber that he would get back to him regarding obtaining the proper permits for the signage on the exterior and the remodeling that was taking place. No other violations were observed at this time.

Investigation revealed there had been a fight inside the store that escalated once the involved parties exited the business. One of the involved parties threatened to return and shoot the armed security guard. The subject who made the threat was cited for disorderly conduct.

- 11. On 02/16/2019 at 3:07pm officers were dispatched to a fight at The Hot Spot, 2643 W. Atkinson Av. The applicant was on scene and stated that Keontray DURRAH came into the store wanting to fight an employee. He stated that DURRAH threw a garbage can spilling it on the floor. He did show the officers a portion of the security video that showed DURRAH throwing the garbage can but refused to show the officers all of the video. The officers spoke with the subject who stated the store manager broke his glasses and he wanted them fixed. The store manager took the glasses to have them fixed.
- 12. On 2/26/2019 at 8:50pm officers conducted a business check at The Hot Spot, 2643 W. Atkinson Av. The officers located a subject in the store smoking a cigarette. He was escorted out of the store. The subject left some property in the store and the officers smelled marijuana coming from his property. They did not locate any marijuana but did locate several more cigarette butts where the subject was sitting, suggesting he had been at that spot for some time. The officers spoke with the applicant about his lack of security, which would have kept the subject from loitering in the store for long periods of time. The applicant stated he had security companies but they quit because they were being harassed by the customers. The applicant stated he would not allow this subject back in his store again.
- 13. On 03/07/2019 officers conducted follow up at The Hot Spot, 2643 W. Atkinson Av, regarding the fight on 02/16/2019. The officers had interviewed the victim of that incident, Keontay DURRAH, who stated he had been beaten by the store owner and his employees and that one of them had pointed an AR-15 rifle at him. The officers spoke with the owner who stated DURRAH was just attempting to get money from him. The officers requested to see the video.

The applicant took them back to the system but appeared to be pulling up the wrong date. The officer advised the applicant he was familiar with his camera system and he could operate it but he then called his attorney who told the officers they would need a warrant to see the video.

The subject was found to be in possession of marijuana and was arrested.

While at the store a B/M later identified as Cameron L. SANDIFER (B/M 12/31/94) entered and began to act in a loud/boisterous manner. SANDIFER was yelling, swearing, and jumping around the store. SALEM-OBAID Uncle identified as Nael N. JABBAR (W/M 07/27/78) walked over to where SALEM-OBAID and SANDIFER were standing. SANDIFER continued to act in a loud/boisterous manner and began to demand to give him his phone. SANDIFER's phone had been plugged in to charge for him. JABBAR gave the phone back to SANDIFER who then left the store.

Approximately 20mins later SALEM-OBAID went outside the store to smoke a cigarette and observed SANDIFER, along with (2) other subjects standing on the north sidewalk next to the store. SALEM-OBAID walked over by SANDIFER to talk with him about why he was acting strange earlier. SANDIFER began to act aggressively towards SALEM-OBAID and stated "we own this block...we will kick your ass". SANDIFER then walked out of view as the other (2) subject approached him. At that time SALEM-OBAID felt something strike his left eye causing pain and bleeding. The other subjects grabbed SALEM-OBAID in an attempt to prevent him from chasing SANDIFER and then let him go. SALEM-OBAID blacked out shortly after but did observed SANDIFER running north bound towards a vehicle. SALEM-OBAID walked back into the store and informed everyone. SALEM-OBAID was driven to the hospital by an employee identified as Salem M. ABDEL-FARES (W/M 05/28/74). SALEM-OBAID was treated at Froedtert Hospital and was diagnosed with a fractured left-orbital.

On 10-18-19 at 8:34 p.m., PO MACRAE and I went to the Hot Spot Convenience Store, located at 2643 W. Atkinson Ave., which is a licensed premise in the city of Milwaukee. We went there to assist Squad 5274 (PO BRANDT and PO MEYER), who went out with a business check. We responded with them, due to the amount of people that are normally congregated inside and out side of the store.

Upon entering the store, we observed several people in the store buying items. There was one security guard working inside of the store, making sure that no problems occurred inside of the store.

The store had a 9:00 p.m. close time and the staff at the store promptly had the customers exit the store. As the customers were exiting the store, I walked around the store and while doing so, observed electronic gambling machines in the middle of the store. While looking at the machines, I observed cigarette butts on the floor, as well as cigarette butts in the cup holders, as well as juice bottles with cigarette butts and clear plastic drinking cups with cigarette butts in the cup. There was the appearance that people were sitting for a long time at the machines, smoking cigarettes as they were playing.

I then conducted a check of the licenses of the business. They were posted in an open space, but the Food Dealer, Cigarette license, W&M license and the Class A license were posted expired on 07-30-19. I then spoke to Amer QADAN, who holds a valid Class D license (230357), which is set to expire 12-31-20. I asked QADAN if he knew where the current licenses were. I informed him I recently watched the license committee hearing for his renewal and that the agent, Nael JABBAR should have his new licenses.

While speaking to QADAN, PO MACRAE was able to speak to JABBAR on the telephone. While speaking to JABBAR, QADAN was able to locate the new licenses. I informed QADAN to throw away the old licenses and post the new, current licenses. PO MACRAE informed JABBAR that we would be fling a license premise report based on the items that caught our attention.

While PO MACRAE continued to speak to JABBAR, I began to have a conservation with Salem ABDEL-FARES (w/m 05-28-74). I asked ABDEL-FARES if he is still in charge of the meat area and he stated yes. I informed ABDEL-FARES of what I observed at the gambling machines. He informed me that the store is very busy and that people play the machines. He stated that since the store is so busy, it is hard to keep an eye on the people playing the machines and when they can watch the people, when they smoke they have them stop smoking or leave.

This report is a narrative of the responding officers to this incident, a subject with gun complaint.

This report was written by Police Officer Brian HOLMES, assigned to District Five, Day Shift. On Wednesday, December 25th, 2019, I was assigned to Squad 5122, along with Police Officer Brian DUERST. Officer DUERST and I were dressed in full Milwaukee Police uniform, and operating a fully marked, black and white, Milwaukee Police Department Squad, vehicle 112. At 10:54 am, Officer HOLMES and I were dispatched to a subject with a gun call located at 2643 W Atkinson Ave which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

While the caller was on the phone with dispatch, heard was a subject yelling "He pulled a gun on me, shoot me, shoot me!" While on the phone the caller stated that threatening to shoot up the store, same subject as yesterday, throwing things round store, with subjects hands in pocket, can not tell if has a firearm.

Upon arrival P.O. DUERST and I located a person matching the subjects description later identified as Xaiver D HARREL in the store. We immediately approached him and patted him down for our safety and did not locate any weapons. We then attempted to escort him outside to interview him when he broke away and fled. Responding squads checked the area but were unable to locate HARREL. We then went back inside the location and and met with the victim.

The Hot Spot LLC is a small grocery/convenience store located on the southeast corner of Atkinson and 26th st. Directly to the left when entering the store is the check out counter area and the majority of the shopping area is straight back and to the right. I noticed multiple food displays were tipped over and the contents were laying on the floor in front of the check out counter. I also observed that the electronic point of sale cash register/credit card reader and the lottery purchasing station were pushed off the counter and laying on the floor or hanging by the power/data cables.

Interview of Ibrahim A ISSA

ISSA stated that HARREL came into the store and started knocking over food displays and acting crazy. ISSA stated they told HARREL to leave but he just kept swearing and acting crazy. ISSA stated that

HARREL then pushed the cash registers off the checkout counter.

Interview of Nael JABBAR

P.O. DUERST and I then met with the store owner Nael JABBAR. JABBAR stated HARREL was at this location last night and causing issues with him and his employees and the police arrived after HARREL had left. JABBAR stated the police wrote a disorderly conduct case for HARREL and he was ordered to appear at the DA's office on 12-27-2019. JABBAR then showed us the security camera footage of the event that occurred on today's date and it matched what ISSA had described to me. JABBAR stated he was very concerned about his and his employees safety at the store and wants to know what he can do to protect himself if HARREL returns. P.O. DUERST and I both stated you can only protect life with deadly force and not property. We also stated that JABBAR would have to be able to articulate his actions if something did occur. JABBAR stated that the electronic point of sale cash registers have an approximate value of \$8000.00 each and the credit card readers are approximately \$300.00. JABBAR was unsure or the value or replacement cost of the lottery purchasing station but would try to get in contact with them and find out. JABBAR stated that one electronic point sale machine was broken along with the credit card reader. He stated that the lottery purchasing station powered up but did not function and they are unable to sell and lottery tickets at this time and this cost the store anywhere from \$800.00 to \$2,000.00 per day.

On 02-28-20 at 8:48 p.m., Sq. 5274 (PO BRANDT) called for squads to respond to the Hot Spot Supermarket, located at 2643 W. Atkinson Ave., for multiple people fighting.

My partner PO Russell MACRAE and I arrived and spoke to PO BRANDT, who stated there were several vehicles parked around the store on W. Atkinson Ave. and on N. 27th St., in the northbound bus lane. PO BRANDT was attempting to get the vehicles to move from the areas where they were illegally parked.

As PO BRANDT was doing this, he looked inside of the store and observed what appeared to be a large fight inside of the store. PO BRANDT went inside of the store and observed two females inside of the store fighting, with many people surrounding them.

PO BRANDT stated there were two security guards working and both were breaking up the fight and get the females outside of the store. PO BRANDT called for more squads to respond to the store and was able to take control of one of the females, while security detained the other, until the arrival of other officers.

I spoke to Nael JABBAR, who is the licensed agent of the business. He stated the store was busy and the two females started to fight inside of the store. He went on to tell me that he knows the two females and that they do not like each other and fight about messing around with a "Babies Daddy". He stated this past summer there was a major fight at the park on N. 25th St. and W. Atkinson Ave. (Atkinson Park) and the two females were the start of a large fight in the park, which required a large amount of police presence to control.

JABBAR stated his security broke up the fight and tried to get the females out of the store and we, the police arrived.

JABBAR stated he wanted the police to inform both females to not return to the store and if they return, he wanted them cited for trespassing. We informed both females of this and PO BRANDT arrested and cited one of the females for disorderly conduct, for fighting at the store. The two females also filled out and signed forms that the store uses for trespassing.

I informed JABBAR that I would be filing this report.
