There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. Hello Ms. McHenry. I hope you are well and had a great/safe weekend. I apologize for the delay in following up on our conversation from last week. I wanted to gather all of the information available in order to provide as full a response as possible. Please find below an email to President Johnson in regards to this matter. Both Mr. Peregory (the District Manager and the Agent on this application) and I remain available to meet with President Johnson and/or any other Alderpersons on this topic.

Dear President Johnson:

Thank you again for your support of our application to obtain a license to sell beer and wine at our store in your ward. We really appreciate your well-considered advocacy for the people of your ward.

I wanted to confirm two commitments I made on the Hearing call and share with you information in regards to another topic raised at that time.

Save A Lot commits that it will not sell any alcohol other than beer and wine at this store. That is our corporate-wide approach to alcohol sales. We view this as an opportunity for our customers to include beer or wine in the basket of food for which they are already shopping.

Save A Lot further commits that it will not sell any single serve beer/wine products.

Alderwoman Dodd shared concerns on the call about Save A Lot effectively managing the shopping carts at/from its store in your ward. Like Alderwoman Dodd, Save A Lot is concerned about people taking our carts. We do not want our property to look unkempt. We do not want our carts disappearing. We understand how it makes the city look to have carts all over. Our stores and the management at them is dedicated to protecting and managing out shopping carts. That is one measure on which store management is evaluated.

As you shared in a previous email, we have been successfully in keeping our store and the exterior around it clean and well-kept. That remains a priority. We have also introduced new cart technology to this store. This technology, provided through a vendor named Gatekeeper Systems, Inc., is installed on each cart and prevents the wheels on the cart from rolling if the cart is taken outside of the Save A Lot parking lot. I have included a photo here of the carts equipped with this technology.



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

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


