This report is written by Police Officer David Novak, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 02/19/2020 at 1:35am officers were dispatched to a Battery at El Coqui Bar, 2078 S 8th St. The applicant stated there was a private party at the bar and she had no security that night. There was a fight inside the bar which started with two subjects fighting. The fight escalated, with multiple people throwing punches and using bottles to hit each other. Two subjects were injured, resulting in stiches to close the wounds. The applicant was on scene and cooperative with the investigation. The applicant provided the video surveillance to the officers.
- 2. On 03/05/2020 a meeting was held at District 2 regarding El Coqui Bar, 2078 S 78th St. The applicant was present and the officers played the video of the fight from 02/19/2020. The video showed the bartender grabbing a gun from under the bar and approaching the fight. The bartender then puts the gun back under the bar, in an unsecured location. The gun remained there until the applicant's husband picked up the gun and put it in his pocket. The applicant was advised the bartender was previously employed at Don Pedro's bar, which was closed down for numerous shot fired calls. The applicant stated she was going to watch the subjects involved in the fight the next time they come in and would probably fire the bartender.

This report is written by PO Benjamin SPITZER, Assigned to District Two, Late Power.

On Wednesday, February 19th, 2020 at 1:35 AM while assigned to Squad 2554, PO Kevin FREY and I, responded to 2078 S. 8th St, El Coqui Bar, for a battery cutting to assist the primary Squad 2325, PO Jimmy MORALES-COLON and Jesus RODRIGUEZ.

Several patrons of a private birthday party were involved in a large physical altercation within the premise with the majority being captured on security cameras. There were two victims of the incident the first victim, identified as Haydeelyn M. CANDELARIA (W/F, 11-29-1992), was observed on video not actively involved in the altercation and appeared to be attempting to break it up. During the course of the altercation CANDELARIA fell down in front of the bar, out of view of the camera. CANDELARIA sustained a laceration to the left side of her forehead which required approximately 40 stitches to close the wound. While squads were on scene investigating a subject, identified as Rafael E. JIMENEZ (W/M, 08-05-1973), returned to the scene. JIMENEZ was later arrested for substantial battery, and possession of cocaine.

The owner of the bar, identified as Brenda M. SALAS (W/F, 05-28-1982), was on scene and was cooperative for the duration of the investigation. SALAS stated that she was holding a private birthday party for a friend. SALAS allowed Officers to view surveillance of the incident. SALAS stated that she has security only on weekends, and did not have security. I advised SALAS of the License Premise report, and that she may want to look into obtaining ID scanners.

Surveillance cameras did capture this incident which depicts the following:

The video only covers a portion of the bar. It should be noted that the video is not accurate with the actual time and the time stamp is off approximately 6 hours from the actual time.

7:25 -The video shows an unknown female and male couple sitting at the bar area, when a subject wearing a red under shirt, black sweater and dark/white baseball cap walks up to her and has a brief interaction.

7:27 The video then shows a brief scuffle where the suspect and another subject seem to argue and shove each other. Eventually multiple subjects begin to throw punches and use items to hit each other.

7:30 The suspect at this point is still inside the bar and is holding two bottles in his hands. The video then briefly shows CANDELARIA attempt to escort the suspect out of the bar.

7:34 The suspect is seen swinging a bottle at the victim striking MELENDEZ-CANDELARIA who then falls onto the floor.

7:33 A female subject removes an object which appears to be a firearm from underneath the counter. The gun was placed int, Hector SALAS-SANTIAGO's (W/M, 09-02-1978), pocket shortly after.

7:36 MELENDEZ-CANDELARIA is back on video covering her head which soaked in blood.

No firearm was recovered during the initial investigation, and at the time it was not known a firearm was recovered until investigating squads reviewed the video after it's recovery.

This report is written by PO Matthew DIENER, assigned to District 2, day shift, squad 2166, Community Prosecution Unit. On Thursday, March 5, 2020, at approximately 1:00pm, District 2 conducted a meeting with Brenda SALAS, the agent/owner of El Coqui Bar, located at 2078 S 8th St. In attendance was Captain Paul LOUGH (District 2), Sgt Chad RADEN (LIU), ACA Heather HOUGH (City Attorney Office), Ms. SALAS, and myself. The meeting was held to discuss a fight/substantial battery that occurred at the premise, during a birthday party on Wednesday, February 19, 2020. During the meeting we played surveillance video captured from inside the premise which showed the incident.

The video showed SALAS' bartender that evening, Omayra CANDELARIA (w/f, 4-18-77), reaching behind the counter of the bar and grabbing a concealed firearm, then walking towards a fighting crowd of people, before returning the firearm back to it's original location. SALAS stated that CANDELARIA was a bartender at Don Pedro's bar, which was located at 1979 S 15th St. We told SALAS that Don Pedro's license was non-renewed due to numerous incidents of shots fired outside the location, complete lack of cooperation with District 2 police, and even refusing police entry when incidents occurred. We told SALAS our concern was that her tavern could attract the same patrons from Don Pedro's, thus continuing the same behavior at her premise.

SALAS stated that they have security at the premise, but only on Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays, and sometimes Sundays. We pointed out the clear and present danger of having an unattended/unsecured firearm inside the premise, where anyone who knows if it's existence could potentially use it for their own purpose. Video shows several patrons, during the fight, making their way behind the bar, unknowingly walking right past to where the firearm is placed. Later in the video, it shows SALAS' husband, Hector SALAS, grabbing the firearm and securing it with him. SALAS stated that the firearm is hers, and it's a .38 revolver. While watching the video, the fight lasted approximately 10 minutes before Hector SALAS is observed with a cell phone to his ear calling police, which occurred only after several people were injured, with one person requiring over 40 stitches as a result.

SALAS was asked how she is going to move forward with managing the premise, to prevent such incidents like this from occurring. SALAS stated that she'll have to keep a close eye on the people who were involved in the incident when they come to bar from now on, and that she'll have to talk with her husband. SALAS also stated that she'll probably fire the bartender who was involved in the incident.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 7/10/2020 at 1:50 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
