4. On 01/12/2019 at 2:01am officers conducted a licensed premise check at Oldies, but Goodies, 3501 N. 6th St. They observed subject urinating outside. The subject stated he was told he could not use the bathroom inside. The officers spoke with the bartender, Peterious WILLIAMS, who stated he did not want the subject back in the bar. no other violations were observed.

5. On 05/04/19 at 8:29pm, Milwaukee Police, while on patrol, observed a large number of vehicles parked in the 600 block of W. Atkinson Avenue where "No Parking" signs are posted. The officers began writing parking citations to the vehicles when they observed patron leaving the establishment at 3501 N. 6th Street with Styrofoam containers of food to retrieve their vehicles which were parked illegally. The officers have, on several occasions, discussed the parking problem with the staff of the tavern and have been trying to work with the establishment to correct the parking problem. The officers did check and found that the tavern did not have a food license issued to them and was told by staff that they had a private party and the food was related to the party. It was later learned that the tavern was open to the

6. On 05/16/19 at 8:38pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 3501 N. 6th Street because their license was expiring on this date. When they entered the tavern, officers observed patrons at the bar, drinking, and signs that stated, "We Sell Pizza - #7 Meat/ \$6 Cheese". The officers also found a freezer full of frozen pizza in the basement and the establishment had no food license. The tavern was ordered to close and the applicant was contacted. The applicant stated that she would remain closed until she is able to acquire a temporary license and she would look into applying for a food license.

On 05-04-19 at or about 8:29 p.m., we observed cars parked on W. Atkinson Ave, in the 600 block, parked on the north and south sides of the street. Both the north and south sides of the street have designated no parking signs posted. We began writing numerous citations for vehicles that were parked in the no parking zone. The only two business open at this time were the Mobil Gas Station, located at 3510 N. 7th St. and the Oldies, but Goodies Bar, located at 3501 N. 6th St.

As we began writing paring citations, we observed several people exiting the Oldies but Goodies bar with Styrofoam containers of food, attempting to get to their vehicles before we could write them parking citations. While writing a parking citation, I observed a female with a plate of food on her dash board, who had left the bar.

After writing several citations, both PO MACRAE and I started to write the citations from N. 7th St., making our way to the east towards the bar on N. 6th St. After getting to my 3rd citation, there were people leaving the from the front of the bar and those people who were leaving moved their vehicles and shortly after both sides of W. Atkinson Ave. were cleared of parked vehicles.

PO MACRAE and I then left the area and drove around the block. PO MACRAE observed a white Nissan Sentra that had parked where we just were writing parking citations. We drove around the block and once we returned, we observed 3 to 4 vehicles now parked in the same spaces that we were writing citations to for no parking. PO MACRAE observed the Nissan Sentra and spoke to the driver; this driver and vehicle were parked at 621 W. Atkinson Ave. As PO MACRAE was speaking to the driver and asked him to step out of his vehicle and as he did, PO MACRAE observed a clear plastic baggie containing suspected marijuana, as well as a clear plastic baggie containing suspected cocaine powder, sitting on the seat that the driver was sitting on.

The driver was arrested for possession of cocaine and possession of marijuana. While at the location, we could not investigate the Styrofoam containers that were coming from the bar due to the arrest.

It should be noted that on several occasions we have gone to the bar and discussed the parking situation with the staff at the bar, making sure that their security informs people that they cannot park on W. Atkinson Ave., in the 600 block, due to the posted no parking signs. We have informed them to have their patrons to park on N. 6th St., in the 3400 block. The bar does not have any patrons parking on W. Keefe Ave. in the 600 block, just W. Atkinson Ave. The bar when busy, the patrons park in the Milwaukee County Transit turn around lot, as well as a vacant lot just to the west of the turnaround lot. This vacant field has a very large for sale sign on the property. We are trying to work with the bar to correct this parking problem.

While at District 5, I checked the licensing system and found that the tavern does not have a valid food dealers license, but a PEP (4588) and BTavern License (205473), which are set to expire on 05-16-19.

We later returned to the bar and spoke to the staff at the bar. We informed them that we observed, while writing parking citations that people were leaving the bar with Styrofoam containers of food. We were informed that as we were writing citations, that there was a private party at the bar and that the food was related to the party and not the bar. Upon further investigation, we had learned that the bar

This Report is written by PO Russell MACRAE assigned to District 5 - LATE POWER TAVERN CAR.

On 05/16/19 at 08:38pm, PO David LETTEER and I (SQ#5468) conducted a Tavern Check at "Oldies But Goodies" located at 3501 N 6th Street. According to our records, the tavern was due for a license renewal due to their Class B License expiring on 05/16/19. Per LIRA, the records in indicated that the tavern still owed payment for the licenses and no new license had yet been granted/approved by the Common Counsel. PO LETTEER and I made contact with the bartender identified as Anthony D. WHITE (B/M 06/18/65) Class D# 0205473. I observed (7) patrons inside the bar drinking and watching the Bucks game. PO LETTEER and I advised WHITE of the situation and asked if he had any possible paperwork incase LIRA was not updated. WHITE could only provide the Class B License that showed an expiration of 05/16/19.

I notified dispatch to send a supervisor regarding. SGT Robert CRAWLEY (SQ#5412) arrived on-scene. PO LETTEER and I advised him of the situation and informed him that we wished for the tavern to close for the night. SGT CRAWLEY stated that he agreed. I informed WHITE that the tavern would be closed until they were able to have the proper licenses. While speaking with WHITE, I observed (2) separate posted signs on the wall/mirror behind the bar stating "We Sell Pizza" - \$7 Meat / \$6 Cheese). I also observed (3) industrial pizza ovens next to the bar, and I also observed a freezer full of frozen pizza in the basement. I asked WHITE if the tavern had a food-dealer license. WHITE stated no. I advised WHITE that they could not sell that type of food without a license. I further informed WHITE that the tavern should acquire a food-dealer license to avoid any further wrongdoings if they continued to sell pizza.

I notified the Licensee identified as Vickie BROOKS (B/F 04/08/67) on 05/17/19 at approximately 10:15pm. I advised BROOKS that her tavern was in violation due to the licenses being expired. I also explained that I had observed evidence that the tavern was selling pizza without a food-dealer license. BROOKS stated that the tavern would remain closed until she is able to acquire a temporary license to operate until the common counsel approves her full license. BROOKS also stated that the pizza sales would stop and she would look into possibly acquiring a food-dealer license as well on Monday.

On 12/12/19 at 10:07 p.m., I conducted license premise check of Oldies, But Goodies, located at 3501 N. 6th St., which is a licensed premise in the city of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, I spoke to the bartender, Anthony D. WHITE (b/m 06/18/65), who has valid Class D License (226660) and is set to expire 12/31/19. I asked if I could see the Class B Tavern License. I was informed by WHITE that the bar never received a hard copy of the Class D License. WHITE stated the license was valid, because it was recently renewed and that I could check it on the computer to make sure it was valid.

I informed him that the bar needed the hard copy at the bar, for inspection by the police. WHITE again told me that the bar never received the hard copy after it was renewed.

I asked WHITE if the bar was going to operate for New Year's Eve. WHITE stated the bar would be open and that they would be open as long as they had patrons. WHITE also informed me that the crowd would be family and friends. I asked WHITE if the bar would have any security and if they would be armed. WHITE stated there would be no security or armed security, that if there was a problem that the family and friends would try to handle the situation.

I gave WHITE my contact card and informed him that if there were problems, to call the district number on the card or the cell number that is going to be used for New Year's Eve. I informed him that if there were problems, the police would respond to help the bar.

Upon concluding my interaction with WHITE, I emailed the listed agent, Vickie BROOKS. I informed her of my visit and the situation with the hard copy of the license. I mailed her, just in case it was a mistake about not having the license at the bar. I informed her that I attempted to print out a copy of the license, but that I could not. I informed her that if she needed another copy, to contact the licensing division in order to obtain another copy.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimonv.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
