LSL Replacement Financial Evaluation

- Common Council File #191432 directed MWW and Budget Office to evaluate financial impacts of expanding City's cost share for lead service line replacement.
- Options available:
 - Utilize rate revenue through Act 137
 - Expand the current city subsidy to include owner initiated



Utilizing Rate Revenue

- Petition Public Service Commission
- Mandate replacement of all LSLs via Ordinance
- Flexible timeline for completion of replacements
- Allows utility to fund:
 - 50% grant for private-owned section (\$2,727)
 - 50% loan for private-owned section (\$2,727)
 - MWW always pays 100% of utility-owned section
- Will require a rate increase for commercial and residential properties
- May allow additional grant from City, not utility

Expand Current Subsidy

- Expand cost subsidy to include owner initiated via Ordinance change
- Current ordinance funds
 - Limits property owner to lesser of 1/3 average cost of private-owned section (\$1,818) or \$1,754 as special assessment/loan
 - Remainder (\$3,700) paid by the City as grant
 - MWW always pays 100% of utility-owned section
