Lawn Bowling Clubhouse

Proposal Add a front porch to the Lawn Bowling Clubhouse by extending the current roof

structure and adding fiberglass columns. This will replace the existing fabric awning. The roof will be extended southward with composition shingles that match the

Lake Park in North Point North

present roofing.

Staff comments The Lawn Bowling Clubhouse is a relatively modern structure in the park dating to

1962.

The design is an excellent effort at matching the aesthetics of the park and the nearby pavilion. Staff has only two concerns. The columns are proposed as

fiberglass and may be too similar to what exists on the pavilion building. The pavilion

has Scamozzi capitals (ionic with diagonally projecting volutes) and unfluted columns. The same is proposed for the clubhouse. Differentiation could be achieved

with true Greek Ionic capitals or with Doric capitals. These would be sufficiently subtle indicators that the building is a different historical era and would avoid the "false sense of history" that we should in a carefully designed landscape such as

Lake Park.

Fiberglass material for the columns is another concern. Staff is unaware of prior approvals of fiberglass in such a highly visible location. Wood columns have been

consistently required of homeowners in the city.

Recommendation Recommend HPC Approval with conditions

Conditions 1. Use different column capitals. Do not copy Scamozzi capitals from pavilion

2. Use wood, compo, or metal columns
