I conducted a Canvass regarding.

Canvass

While on scene I spoke to the caller, [REDACTED], who stated that approximately between the hours of 1:39 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. she heard approximately four shots in front of her residence at 128 W. Lapham St. [REDACTED] stated she observed a dark colored Ford Focus possibly (Green) in color. The vehicle was parked across the street from her house, [REDACTED] stated a black male exited the vehicle and brandished a firearm and shot in the air then drove off headed eastbound. TORRES stated he was the only one in the vehicle. [REDACTED] S stated she had no further information regarding.

I also spoke with [REDACTED] (w/m 11-06-00) who stated he has cameras at his residence at 1618 S. 2nd St. that might have caught the incident.

[REDACTED] has four working cameras but only two were facing towards the incident location. One camera is facing north east towards the street and alley. The other camera is facing eastbound towards the Scrub -A- Dub parking lot.

I reviewed [REDACTED]'s cameras and observed several people running and ducking and getting into they're cars. I could not identify who fired the weapon based of the footage.

I also spoke with [REDACTED] (w/f 12-05-78) who stated she did not observe anything. But she did hear approximately 10 gun snots at approximately 2 a.m.. She had no further information.

When we arrived we spoke to Johnny W. BURKS (B/M, 12-29-81) the security guard at the bar Points View Boite bar who stated that a white Suburban was seen driving northbound on S. 1st St. when it approached the front of the bar and started to fire approximately 10-15 shots into the air. BURKS stated that he saw two males inside the vehicle.

As my partner and I located casings another call for police came in from St. Francis Hospital stating that a shooting victim had arrived who stated that he was shot on 1st and Lapham Blvd.

We then changed locations to St. Francis Hospital and located the victim who was later identified as _____ (B/M, 09-14-92) and a witness. My partner spoke with the victim see his detail reports regarding.

While on scene I spoke with _____ the shooting victim.

_____ (B/M, 01-24-95) who stated that he was the brother of

Interview of _____ (B/M, 01-24-95)

_____ stated that this morning while he was driving by Points View Bar his cousin called him asking him where he was, _____ stated that as he was on the phone he could hear people arguing in the background. _____ stated that as he kept trying to figure out what was going on he then heard multiple gunshots. I stated at this point he was outside by the Scrub-A-Dub as people were running and the gunfire continued. _____ stated that he then found his brother. _____ stated that he noticed the gunshot on his brother and initially was going to drive him out to Froedtert Hospital but got lost since he was not familiar with the south side. _____ stated that he then drove out to the nearest hospital, _____ said that he was able to find St. Francis Hospital and drove there instead. _____ said he and his brother were the only occupants of the vehicle and when they arrived to the hospital multiple subjects followed them there. _____ said that one of his cousins then asked him to borrow the car to go home, _____ said that he gave the keys and expected for his cousin to return later after he and his brother were done at the hospital.

This supplemental report is being written by P.O. Nathan ENK assigned to District Two, Late Shift.

On Sunday March 8, 2020 at 1:44 AM my squad partner P.O. Christopher GREER and I were dispatched to the location of S. 2nd St. and W. Orchard St., in the City and County of Milwaukee for a Shooting Complaint. We arrived on scene at 1:49 AM with our Axon body cameras attached.

Upon arrival my partner and I were able to set up containment for the scene with police tape and flares. I



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also was able to interview potential witnesses inside Points View Boite (Night Club) located at 1619 S. 1st St., in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Interview of (B/M 8-6-84)

MCGOWAN stated he is a security guard for Point View Boite and was unable to see or hear anything regarding the gun shots. MCGOWAN stated the reason he could not see or hear anything is because he was inside while it occurred. MCGOWAN stated he did not see anything that sparked his attention inside that could have caused this.

Interview of (B/M 12-24-81)

BURKS stated he is also a security guard for Point View Boite and was in fact outside while the gun shots were going off. BURKS stated while outside he heard shots going off and saw a white or silver SUV speeding off. BURKS stated he also seen people running and "ducking" down all around him. BURKS stated he really did not see much more.

Interview of G (W/F 10-20-98)

MALMBERG stated she is a server (shot girl) for Point View Boite and was unable to see anything that happened outside regarding the gun shots. MALMBERG stated she did hear three to five gunshots outside of the "night club". MALMBERG stated while inside she did not see anything that seemed out of place between anyone. MALMBERG stated she is constantly running around.

I also was able to review video surveillance provided from the owner at Point View Boite.

Video Surveillance

I was able to review multiple angles inside and outside of Point View Boite. I observed a newer model white Cadillac Escalade parked in the Scrub-A-Dub parking lot directly north of the location at 1635 S. 1st St., in the City and County of Milwaukee. I observed the Escalade to have three chrome rims but on the front right side passenger was a black rim. I observed three black males enter the vehicle with one that is unknown race/gender and the front right side passenger to stand out. He is described as a black light skin male that is bald also wearing glasses.

He had an all blue Nike sweat suit on that had squares on the sleeves and pants. He also was clean shaven with a five o'clock shadow. I'm unable to describe the other three people as of this time but will do further investigation with video in hand. I also heard the shots to be fired at approximately 1:40 AM



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with everyone running and "ducking". As the gun shots were going off there was a multitude of other gunshots to be going off. The gunshots sounded to be different.

On Sunday, March 8th at 3:30AM, I was dispatched to assist in a shooting investigation at S 1st st and W Lapham blvd (Points View Boite- located at 1619 S 1st st). On scene I was instructed to enter the bar and canvass the subjects inside the bar.

I spoke with the following subjects in the following order:

8-13-1991)

MIKOLAJCZYK is a bartender at the "Points View Boite." She stated that she was outside on the porch on the south side of the building taking a smoke-break when she heard the gun fire. MIKOLAJCZYK stated that she jumped on the ground to protect herself. She stated she heard approximately 5-6 shots but did not see anything due to the tall wooden fence around the outdoor area of the club. By the time she had gathered her thoughts and recovered to her feet, law-enforcement was already on scene.

(FW 112-12-2000)

SANTOS is a bartender at the establishment and was working inside, behind the bar when the shooting occurred. SANTOS heard approximately 5-6 shots fired outside and ducked, but did not see anything outside.

↓ (M/W 5-17-1973)

SUTTON is a barback at the establishment. He was inside during the incident. SUTTON stated he was in the center of the floor space near the restrooms when the incident occurred. SUTTON heard 5-6 rounds fired outside the building but did not know where the gunfire came from or who had been shooting.

W 12-28-1998)

PERIBAN-CHAVEZ works serving the bottle-service at the establishment. She stated that she did not hear anything but was inside the club standing along the north wall in the second booth.

30-1989)

RIDGEWAY works security in the building. He state that just prior to last call (RIDGEWAY could not provide a time) he was inside the club walking to the door, checking that patrons were not leaving with liquor bottles. As he stepped into the doorway, he observed a "white or silver" SUV similar to a "Tahoe" or a "Yukon" driving northbound on S 2nd st in front of the club. He observed a subject firing a weapon into to the air approximately 5 or 6 times. RIDGEWAY had no description of the of subject firing the weapon, the weapon itself nor where the suspect was sitting in the vehicle. The vehicle was last seen Northbound on S 1st st from W Lapham blvd

Detective Michael Lees, assigned to the Robbery Unit, CIB, Late Shift types this report.

On Sunday, March 8, 2020, at 3:36 AM, I was briefed by Lt. Patrick Pajot to respond to a Shooting at 1st and Lapham, located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Upon arriving on the scene at 3:47 AM, Squad 2327, Police Officer Joshua Quinones-Davila, and squad 9343, Police Officer Elizabeth Rubio, who was at the hospital with the victim, briefed me of this assignment. After PO Rubio informed me I conducted a walk through and located the scene of the shooting in the rear of 1635 S 1st Street (Scrub-a-dub) located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. There were two other scenes at 121 W Lapham and 1601 S 1st Street (America Best Quality Coatings). I then conducted the scene investigation.

Synopsis

I located three separate shooting locations. The First was the rear of Scrub-a-Dub located at 1635 S 1st Street. Here, I found 7 USA .223 Caliber Remington Brass spent casings, and 3 Winchester 9mm Luger Brass spent casings. These items were marked with Yellow Markers 1 through 10. The second location was north through the alley of Scrub-a-Dub just past the mouth of the alley with a location of 121 W Lapham Street. Here, I located 3 Hornady 9mm Luger Brass spent casings. These items were later marked with Yellow Markers 11 through 13. East of this location and across from Scrub-a-Dub was Milwaukee County Transit Service with an address of 1710 S Kinnickinnic Ave. Just north of the MCTS was the Third Scene with an address of 1601 S 1st Street. This was a closed business with the name of America Best Quality Coatings. Here, I located 14 Federal 40 Caliber Brass spent casings. These items were later marked with Yellow Markers 14 through 28. North of America Best Quality Coating was U-Haul with an address of 1500 S 1st Street. U-Haul was closed during late shift hours. I located cameras in the following locations. Points View Boite located at 1619 S 1st St. (Squad 2326 Police Officer Nathan



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Enk reviewed the video surveillance. This video was recovered on the scene by Squad 1921 F.I. James Peterson. See Enk's report. There were cameras next to Points View at the Scrub-a-Dub 1635 S 1st Street, but this business was closed during this investigation. I observed a camera at 1618 S 2nd Street. Squad 2327, Police Officer Joshua Quinones-Davila reviewed these cameras. See his report.

Further, PO Quinones-Davila reported a witness stated that she observed a B/M subject wearing dark clothing firing a gun in the air at 121 W Lapham. This subject had fled eastbound on W. Lapham in what she believed was a green Ford Focus. See his report.

Scene Investigation

Before conducting measurements, I had done a walk-through of the scene. The scene was located outside. The incident occurred during the hours of darkness, the temperature during the investigation was approximately 41 Degrees Fahrenheit, with mostly clear skies and a wind from the South South-West at 11 Miles Per Hour. The humidity was 51 percent, and it had felt like it was 34 Degrees Fahrenheit. There was no traffic at the time of this investigation due to the alley and roads being blocked. Ambient lighting from businesses and utility poles generated fair lighting conditions.

Scene and Measurements

The evidence (casing) was recovered from the shooting scene. All of my measurements were done using a measuring Bosch Professional GLM 50c Laser and determined several reference points to be the light poles. The first Reference Point was at the rear of 1635 S 1st. I used an electrical post with a metal plate affixed to it, identifying it as 08-07200. The second Reference Point was a street lamp with an address of 121 W Lapham Street. My last Reference Point was a Light Pole on the west side of the street in the middle of the median with an address of 101 W Lapham Street. After measurements were complete and photographs were taken, I collected the casings and placed them on the Milwaukee Police Inventory. Measurements are estimates and not approximates.

Scene One- 1635 S 1st Street

This was the Scrub-a-Dub parking lot. The parking lot east of the reference Point was 140 feet east and west and 92.11 feet going North and South. There was an alley, which was 19.9 feet wide by 231 feet long. The alley separated the main parking lot and entered into the back lot. This backlot is where the scene was recorded. The Reference Point was the first Electrical Post, which opened up the parking



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lots. I noted in the southwest corner of the back lot next to a chain-link 8-foot fence with barb wire on top a 2013 Black Nissan Altima 4DR bearing WI plates AFF5836, VIN: 1N4AL3AP9DN519667 backed into the spot and the front was facing east. This auto listed to an Eleazar Ramirez Lopez (W/M, 08/14/1970 of 1634 S 2nd Street). Three casings were 9 mm next to this auto and were listed as Yellow Markers 8-10. Three parking spaces to the north of this auto were .223 spent casings. They were marked with Yellow Markers 2-7. Directly in front of my R.P. was a spent .223 casing, which was marked with Yellow Marker 1.

Dashed white lines separated the lanes. I measured that the roadway was a total of 88.2 feet Wide with the two lanes being 34 feet and a 20-foot grass median. There were 3 spent 9 mm casings and were identified as being Yellow Markers 11 through 13. This R.P. was about 137 Feet from R.P. 1.

22:40 stated that he actually met up with I and gave the keys to him so that they could get to "EO". stated that he could not remember much from last night because he had been drinking.

26:25 I stated that he drove back up to the hospital because M. told him to bring back the Impala because the police wanted to search it. stated that he when he pulled up to the hospital, he grabbed some money that was in the car.
