Additionally, I am not prohibited from discussing these matters with my union representative on the further conditions that I notify my union representative of the confidential nature of these discussions and that my union representative agrees to keep these matters confidential.

I understand that by providing truthful statements I will not be subjected to disciplinary action and my statements cannot be used against me in a criminal proceeding. I further understand that by being exempt from disciplinary action and criminal prosecution, I have no right to representation under Wisconsin Statute § 164.02.

I understand that by failing to abide by this order, I could be subjected to disciplinary action pursuant to the Code of Conduct Core Value 5.00 - Guiding Principal 5.03 and Core Value 3.00 - Guiding Principal 3.04. I further understand that my failure to provide truthful statements could result in disciplinary action pursuant to Core Value 3.00 - Guiding Principal 3.11.

Core Value 5.00 – Respect; Guiding Principal 5.03: Members shall promptly obey any proper or lawful order emanating from any officer of higher rank. Any improper or unlawful order should be reported to a supervisor of higher rank.

Core Value 3.00 – Integrity; Guiding Principal 3.04: Department members shall treat the official business of the department as confidential, not imparting it to anyone, either orally, electronically or in writing, except those for whom it is intended or under due process of law.
