Upon arrival, officers observed at least 35 vehicles in the parking lot with at least 75 persons sitting on roofs of vehicles, yelling, and dancing. When police arrived, the vehicles began to leave the lot at a high rate of speed in different directions. The caller/employee was interviewed and he stated that he was scared to tell the protesters to leave and that security left at 2:33am, before the call for service was sent to police. The caller also said that this has been an ongoing issue for the past couple of nights, which is evident by showing 4 "ShotSpotter" calls on 06/08/20. The employee was cooperative with providing information.

This report is written by P.O. Nicolas FERRANTE, assigned to District 5, Late Shift, Squad 5322 (with P.O. PETTERSEN.)

On Tuesday, June 9, 2020 at approximately 2:45 AM, Squad 5322 was dispatched as a backing squad for squad 5320 (P.O. COLWELL, and P.O. BELL) for an Entry call for service at 2620 W Capitol Dr. Upon arrival on scene I observed at least 35 cars in the parking lot which was overflowing into the street. I observed multiple subjects at least 75 sitting on roofs of cars, and subjects yelling and dancing. Subjects were also blowing horns of the cars, and yelling through different amplification devices. The dispatched call was for an Entry and stated that a group of "protesters were attempting to kick his door down."

As we arrived on scene all vehicles began to leave the parking lot at high a rate of speed in multiple directions, with a majority going W/B on W Capitol Dr.

A check of the prior call history going back to March 13, 2020 shows 25 calls for service.

On Monday June 8th, 2020 from 2:02 AM, to 2:05 AM, 4 shot spotter calls for service came over.

I spoke with Singh SURJIT (A/M 12-6-97) who is an employee of the gas station who stated that he was scared to tell all the subjects in the lot to leave. SURJIT stated that normally the security guard they have works from 7PM to 5AM, but the security guard had punched out at 2:33 AM, shortly before the call for service came over. The gas station employee (SURJIT) stated that this has been an ongoing issue for the past couple nights.

SURIIT was able to provide me with all licenses posted behind the counter, and was cooperative with providing information.

Licenses posted for: Cigarette and Tobacco, Filling Station, Food Dealer Retail, Weights and Measures, and an Extended Hours license.



The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 9/8/2020 at 2:20 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
