- F. Applicants shall agree to have their photo taken at the time of application. Applicant-submitted photographs shall be accepted provided the photo the complies with Rule VI.F.5 The City Clerk may refuse to accept an applicant-submitted photograph if it does not substantially resemble the applicant or if it is not compliant with these rules. An applicant with a seriously held religious conviction that does not allow the applicant to be photographed may complete, sign, and date a statement certifying that the person objects to being photographed due to seriously held religious convictions.
- 5. In addition to complying with Rule VI.F.1-4, applicant-supplied photos shall be:
 - a. Clear, full color, printed on 2×2 inch photo quality paper with the head centered and sized between 1" and 1.5".
 - b. Having been taken within the previous six months.
 - c. Properly exposed, without shadows, filters, or unnatural colors.
 - d. Taken in front of a white or off-white background by another person. "Selfies" will not be accepted.
