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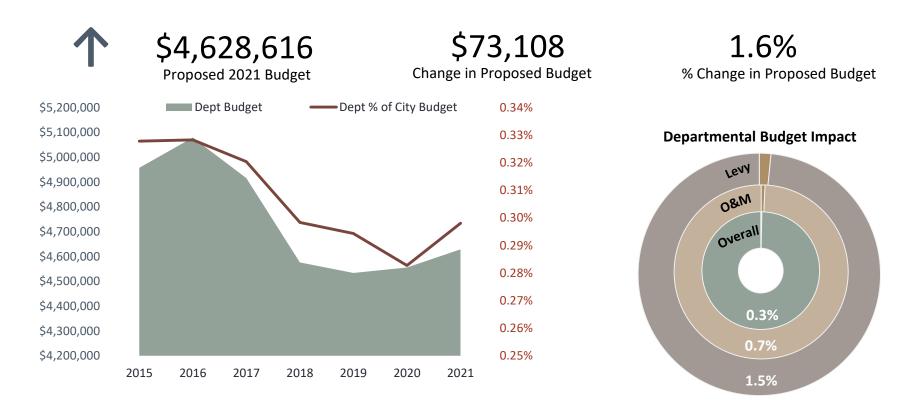

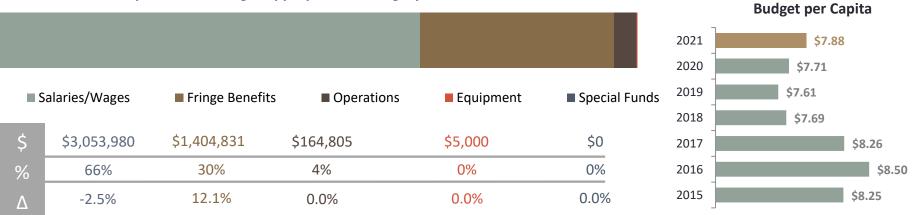

Departmental Budget Appropriation Category



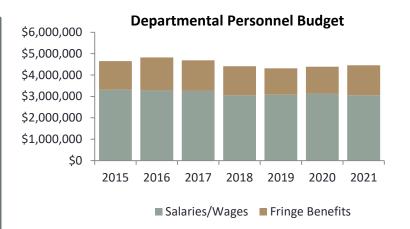


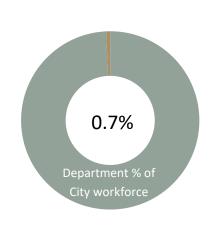
8 of 59 department personnel will be eligible for retirement in 2021.

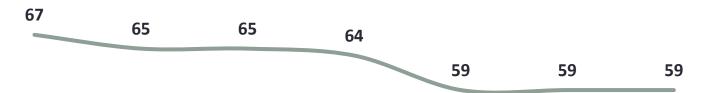

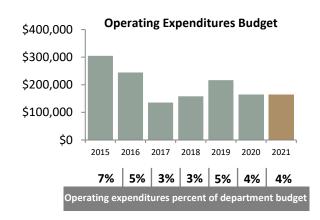

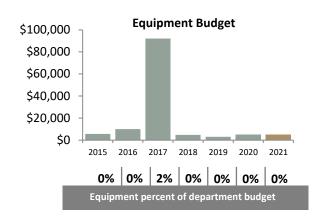
