2021 Budget Summary

- 1. 2021 Proposed Budget: \$51.3 million
 - \$43.3 million in anticipated grants
 - \$8 million in unanticipated grant authority
- 2. Seven departments anticipate operating grant funding in 2021
- 3. 47 separate anticipated grants
- 4. \$922,000 average anticipated grant amount
- CDBG and HOME grants comprise 46.6% of total grant funding
