

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report was submitted by Officer Frederick TERRIQUEZ assigned to District 6, Early shift.

On Thursday, August 13th, 2020 at 6:05pm, I, squad 6240 was dispatched to a shoplifting complaint at the Dollar General Store, 4130 S. Howell Av. The caller. Jelsyn stated someone just entered the store, grabbed a tote and filled it with laundry soap and ran out the back door.

Scene:

The business at 4130 S. Howell Av. is located on the east side of s. Howell Av. and has its' front doors on the south west corner of the building. an emergency exit door is located on the north west corner of the building. The registers line up across the south wall with shopping aisles running north and south the entire interior of the store.

Interview with Jelsyn NUNEZ:

Upon arrival, I spoke to the manager on duty, Jelsyn NUNEZ, h/m, 04-09-96 who stated that a subject entered the store at 4:20pm, selected a plastic tote and began filling it with various laundry soap products. The subject also began stuffing his shirt with merchandise as well. The subject then fled the store with the merchandise through the north exit door at 4:25pm

The subject was described as a black male, 6 foot tall, 220lbs, between the age of 35-40 years. This subject was wearing a gray shirt and Blue jeans.

Jalsyn stated there was another black male in the drivers side of a vehicle parked on the side of Howell Av. The vehicle was described as a Black Nissan hatchback bearing WI plate of AEH-5861. The suspect entered the passenger side of this vehicle which then fled north bound on S. Howell Av.

I asked Jalsyn for a list of the merchandise that was taken form the store and for a copy of the video from their surveillance cameras. Jalsyn stated he did not know what items were taken or their value. He stated he would have to have the assistant manager look through the video and calculate what was taken and have it ready for me the following day. I gave Jalsyn my contact card and told him I would return the following day.

Investigation:

The above plate listed to a 2015 Nissan Versa hatchback, black in color and the listed owner as Tracy N. ROBINSON, DOB of 03-04-82, of 2618 W Galena St, Milwaukee WI 53205.

This case is pending follow up with the owner and the vehicle used in this offense as well as determining the identification of the suspects.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 9/29/2020 at 1:50 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel — Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable — or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
