The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 2. On 06/27/2003 at 9:50 PM officers responded to the licensed premises at 4040 S 27th St, Olympic Lanes regarding a man with a gun complaint. The witness stated that he was approached by an unknown subject who asked him to "step outside". Upon doing so, the suspect displayed a handgun, "cocked it back a few times, called out to his friends, then" left. No further information. Incident Report Filed
- 3. On 04/17/2018 officer's conducted a license premises check on JB's on 41, 4040 S 27<sup>th</sup> St. The officer spoke with the bartender, Michael KUECHENMEISTER, who did not have a Class D Operator's license. The manager, Stephanie ANDERSON, was also not licensed. On 04/28/2018 the officer conducted a follow up check and there was a licensed bartender.

4. On 04/13/19 at 11:45pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4040 S. 27<sup>th</sup> Street for a fight complaint. Investigation revealed that a fight erupted between two subjects by the pool tables. Staff broke up the altercation and the parties left in vehicles before police arrival. The on duty manager worked well with the officers while they gathered information on the incident.

5. On 10/18/19 Milwaukee Police initiated an underage compliance check with a police aide who was under the age of 21. At approximately 9:55PM a police officer and a police aide entered JB's on 41 Bar, located at 4040 S. 27<sup>th</sup> St. The police aide requested a beer from the bartender, who did check identification, however, sold the beer to the underage anyway. The manager on duty was advised and the bartender was cited for the violation.

#### INITIAL INVESTIGATION

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This report was written by P.O. Shawn SWITZER, assigned to District Six, Late Power Shift, Squad 6468.

On Friday, October 18, 2019 District Six Power Shift Squads 6468, 6467 and 6411 initiated an underage compliance check. During the checks, one plain clothed Police officer (P.O.) and one plain clothed Police Aide (P.A.) attempted to enter several taverns throughout District Six. The Police Aide was under the age of 21.

Squad 6468, P.O. Shawn SWITZER and P.O. Christpoher JACKSON.

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Squad 6467. P.O. Paige CARLONI and P.A. Christopher ROMERO-SANCHEZ.

Squad 6411. Sgt. Cassandra BENITEZ

Both the Police Officer and the Police Aide were given instructions prior to conducting the compliance checks. Plain clothed personnel were instructed not allowed to consume any alcoholic beverages. The plain clothed Police Officer was given discretion to provide their identification cards at the bar, the Police Aide was instructed to say they did not have any identification wen asked and to state their true age. The Police Officer was instructed to not purchase anything at the bar, the Police Aide was instructed to purchase a bottle of Miller Lite or a similar bottle of beer. The police Officer took a photograph of the underage Police Aide while the Police Aide was holding the bottle of beer.

On Friday, October 18, 2019 at approximately 9:55 pm P.A. Christopher ROMERO-SANCHEZ and P.O. Paige CARLONI entered JB's on 41 bar located at 4040 S 27th st. P.A. ROMERO-SANCHEZ approached the bar and spoke with the bartender Sarah E HUG (10-12-97). P.A. ROMERO-SANCHEZ ordered a Budlite beer in a glass bottle from HUG who asked him for his identification, P.A. ROMERO-SANCHEZ when he did not provide her his identification she still sold him the beer. HUG charged P.A. ROMERO-SANCHEZ \$3.50 for the Budlite. P.O. CARLONI then took a photograph of P.A. ROMERO-SANCHEZ in possession of the beer while inside of JB's on 41 using a department issued cellular phone. The images were placed on inventory (#19035275). The serial number for the cellular phone is 014391000473121.

At approximately 1:01 am P.O. JACKSON and I returned to the bar and spoke with the manager who was on duty at the time. He stated that HUG was the one working the bar at the time of the incident and stated she was the one who sold the beer. He was able to provide HUG's information.

Hug was issued a citation by mail (#M580VN0036).

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 9/29/2020 at 2:10 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
