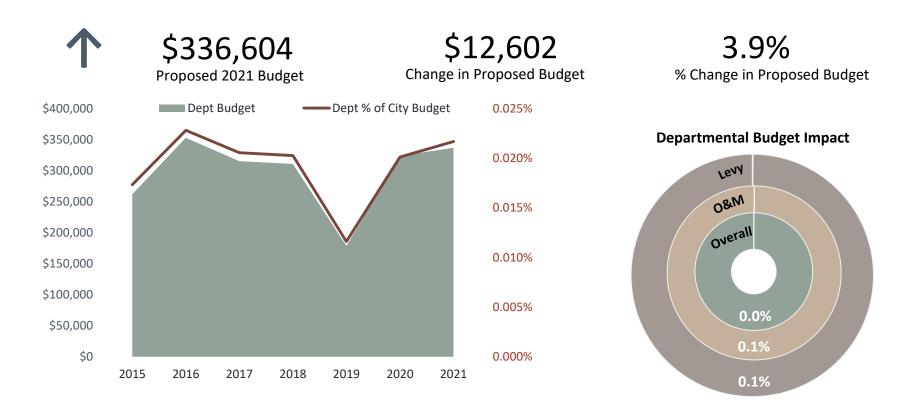

# **Departmental Budget Appropriation Category**

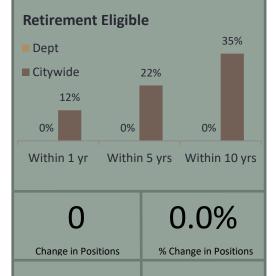


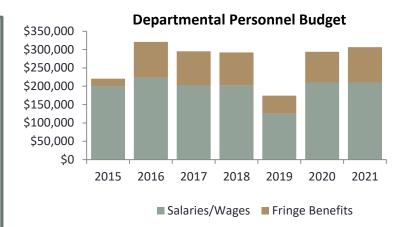


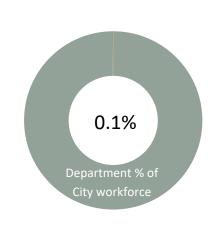
Decrease in the department's Operating Expenditures, 2019 to 2020 (-29.7%). Actual 2018 expenditures were \$18,425.

Difference between the department's actual revenues and actual expenditures in 2018; comparable figure for 2017 was -\$48,791.





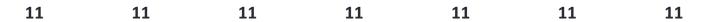


## **Staffing Vacancies**

- The Office Assistant IV position is currently vacant. This is one of the 3 full-time positions in the BOZA office; it was also vacant last October, at the time of 2020 Budget review.
- The filling of this vacancy requires re-approval by the Finance and Personnel Committee.

### **City Staff vs. Board Positions**

- While the Board of Zoning Appeals has 11 authorized positions, 7 are actually members of the Board, not O&M-funded regular City employees.
- Of the 4 regular, non-Board positions, one is actually a half-time employee (Office Assistant III).

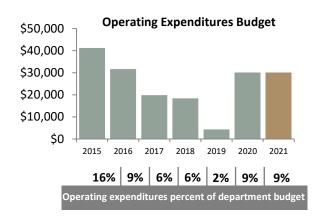

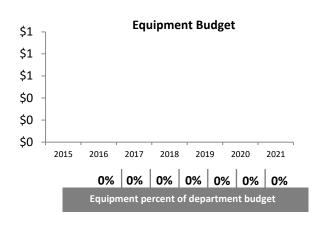
