- Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations): The feasibility study will analyze implementation of alternative holiday make up garbage and recycling collection schedules for all 1 – 4 unit households serviced citywide. Currently, the City's garbage and recycling collection pick-ups move forward one day after each holiday. The feasibility study will examine resources needed to allow recycling and garbage collection schedules to avoid shifting forward after each holiday and remain on the same day of the week during scheduled collections.

Consistent collection aims to increase recycling participation, divert greater amounts of recoverable materials from the landfill, and save on waste disposal tipping fees.
