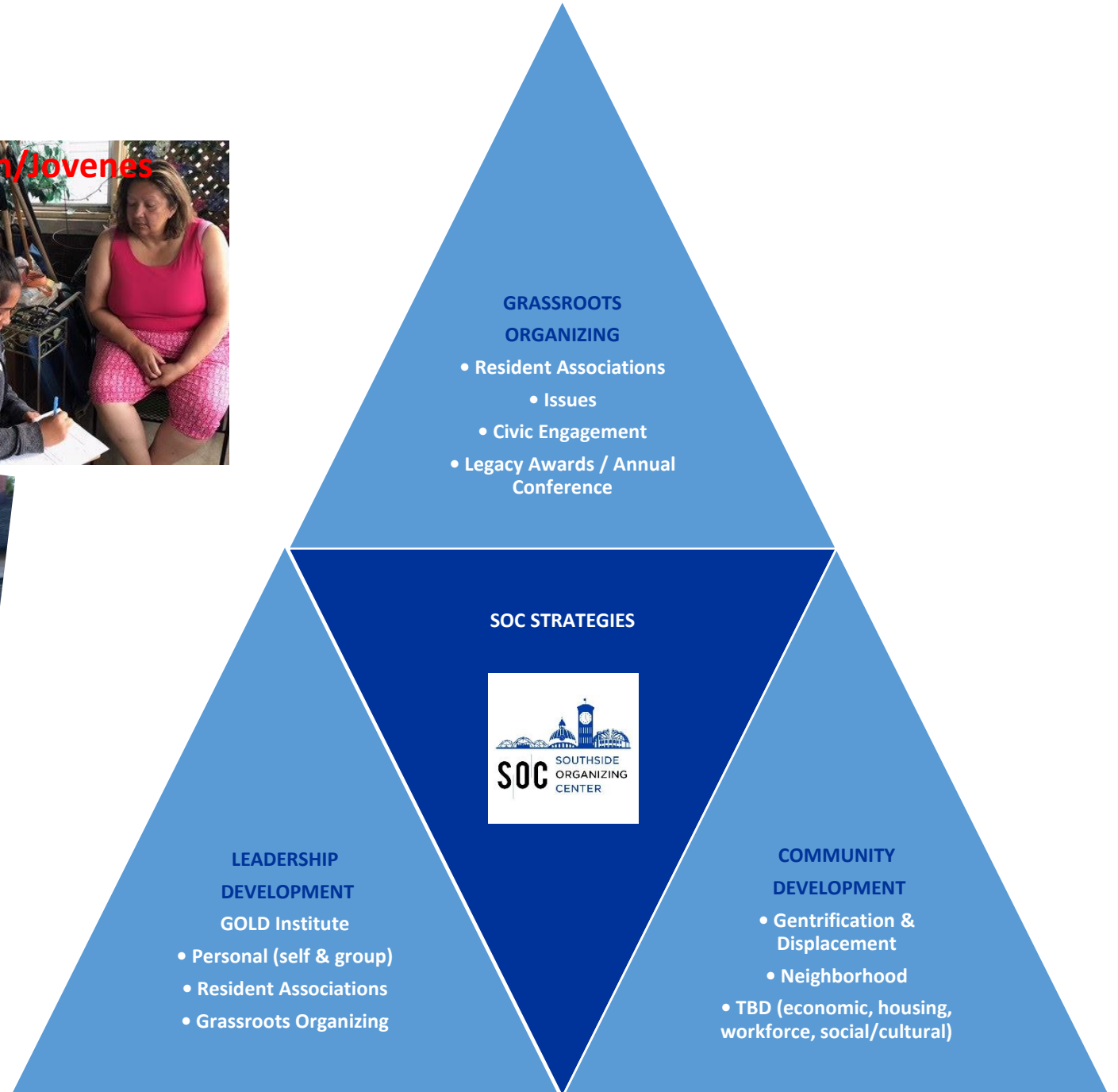




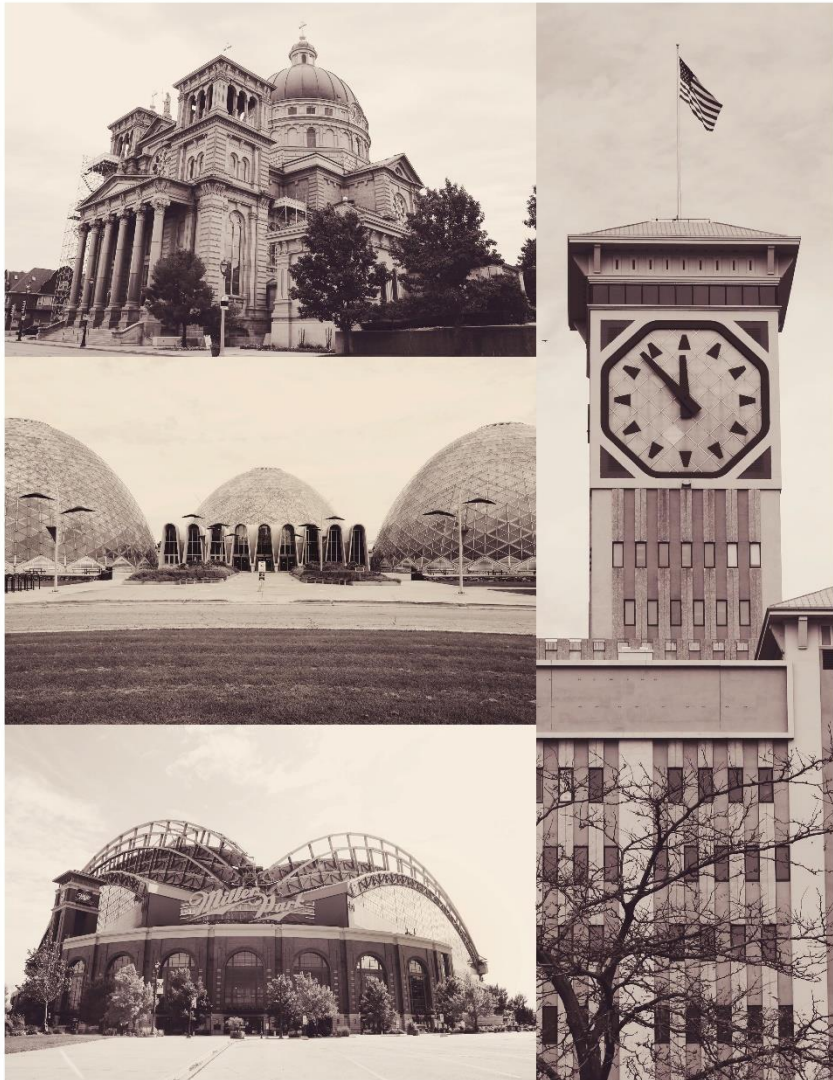

10 Facts about Milwaukee's Near Southside (NSS)

- 1) Most densely pop. area in WI
- 2) 90,000 residents – 27,000 householdss - 3x3 miles
- 3) Most diverse area in WI (70% L, 20% W & 8% B)
- 4) Most concentration of non-English speaking residents in WI
- 5) 20% of adult Latino/a/x population primarily Spanish speaking
- 6) One of the only areas experiencing growth in the City
(including threats from gentrification & displacement)
- 7) Younger community with more than 50% under the age of 30
- 8) Historic immigrant arrival spot with 101 nations counted
- 9) 1/2 of neighborhoods fall within the federal low-income levels
- 10) 2 highest violent crime neighborhoods in the City



SOCIAL JUSTICE = MORAL DECLARATION

(articulated & documented principles that are quantifiable, reviewed/evaluated/audit, and adjusted)

SYSTEM REFORM

- Legislated and Funded Offices/Commissions/Projects that integrate former community efforts
- Especially development/investment efforts/opportunities/contracts/public services & % of budgets dedicated to grassroots community engagement
- Measurably representative of community executive to front line positions
- Measurably centers and is lead/governed by neighbors with lived experiences
- Advocacy & challenges be welcomed, and community trafficking eliminated
- Positions allies as support

PEOPLE (engaged people who will self-determine in balance with other people)

- Indigenous First Peoples
- Impoverished/Working Poor
- Immigrant protection and honored
- Past like Kashubs & present undocumented including ITIN & restricted resources
- Latino/a/s (undocumented)
- African American (Involuntary Immigrants/Enslaved)
- Asian

- Youth (education & employment)

GRASSROOTS

- Inclusive & accessible (outreach, venues, systems, languages, ADA, integrated, times, financing to compete against basic needs & review systems)
- Community grassroots strengthening like resident associations (emerging in the system and challenged with infrastructure elements that prevents their contribution)
- Opportunity to review HUD funding cost reporting with new Comptroller

- informed by research by academics with lived experience and/or representative of community

ISSUES

- Safety
 - Especially from our hired law enforcement (non-militarized not even donated) & self impacted corrections like lawsuits & uniform union status
 - Integrated former, CCC. frontline demands
 - Appropriate responders
 - FPC independence
 - Over policing, criminalizing, incarcerating, holistic intervention & obstructive reintroduction
 - Transparency like Joel Acevedo
 - Invitation for safe feedback
