This report is being written by P.O. Ana ROMERO-PEREZ, assigned to District 6, Late Shift.

On January 21, 2020 at approximately 5:39 AM, I was dispatched to a Business Burglary alarm AT 1503 E Oklahoma Av in the City and County of Milwaukee. Unknown actor(s) intentionally and without consent gained entry through the North side of the building by breaking a window. I along with squad 6360 P.O. CONNER and 6390 P.O. RODRIGUEZ cleared the building and observed open register, a Markers Mark bottle on the floor and other miscellaneous items on the floor. The audible alarm was going off in the building.

Outside of the business, I observed a black straw, one dollar bill, a pack of cigarettes and chap stick.

Upon review video surveillance I observed a white male wearing a black jacket, black hat, black gloves and black jacket with black shoes outside of the bar at 4:43 AM at 4:44 AM the subject gained entry to the business by breaking the window on the front door and putting his hand through the door and unlocking it. The suspect goes behind the bar, opens register and notices no money inside. Then the subject looks around and observes jars filled with money. Subject stuffs his pockets with money and runs out of the bar at 4:49 AM.

The business closed at 2:00 AM that night.

Upon arrival, I noticed approximately 15 people inside the bar. (Sitting at the counter and playing billiards) I spoke to the owner, Derek A. DONALDSON, w/m, 02-10-73. I advised him that there was complaint against the bar being overcrowded and that patrons are not following the recommended 6 foot distancing. Officers asked for voluntary compliance.

Derek understood the situation at stated he would comply voluntary but would need 15 minutes to make preparations.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


