This report is written by Police Officer David Novak, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 10/12/2019 at 8:53pm officers conducted a license premise check at Rose's Place, 2878 N. 20<sup>th</sup> St. The officer attempted to open the door and found it locked. He pressed the doorbell next to the door and the bartender buzzed him in. The bartender showed the officers the business licenses and his Class D Operator's license. The bartender stated the business would be open on New Year's Eve with three bartenders. The officer advised to call the police if any problems occur. The officers advised the bartender that the agent would have to explain why the doors are locked.
- 2. On 03/17/2020 at 8:20pm officers conducted a license premise check at Rose's Place, 2878 N. 20<sup>th</sup> St. The officer found the bar to be closed in compliance with the Governor's order.
- 3. On 04/17/2020 at 1:05am officers observed four subjects exiting Rose's Place, 2878 N. 20<sup>th</sup> St. The officers then conducted a license premise check. The front door was locked but a subject, who identified himself as the manager, opened the door. The manager stated there was only himself and one other subject cleaning the business. He did later admit that there were people in the bar. The officers advised him the business does not have a food license and is considered nonessential, so it must be closed by the current order issued by the Governor.

This license premise report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5 Late Power Shift Tavern Sq. 5468.

On 12/12/19 at 8:53 p.m., I conducted a license premise check of Rose's Place, located at 2878 N. 20th St., which is a license premise in the city of Milwaukee.

Upon walking up to the front door, I attempted to enter the establishment, but the door was locked. There is a door bell next to the door, which when pressed, allowed the bartender to open the door from the bar. I entered the bar and spoke to the bartender Dwayne HARDWICK (Sr.)(b/m 01-/12/61) who has a Class D Operator's license (225234), which is set to expire on 12/31/19. HARDWICK then showed me the current Class B Tavern License (207798), which is valid until 12/03/20.

HARDWICK stated the owner is having health problems and that he is there helping the owner out until she gets back on her feet. He stated he is bartending here, as well as several other taverns, helping out when he can. I observed that HARDWICK was wearing a firearm, along with a pouch containing two magazines. He stated he has his gun with him, along with his CCW permit. He carry's his gun in case something happens, but if something happens, he first tries to defuse the situation with his words.

HARDWICK stated the bar was open, but he had no customers and was in the bar by himself tonight.

I asked him what was going to happen with the bar on New Year's Eve. HARDWICK stated the bar would be open. That it would be 3 bartenders, as well as himself. He stated for New Year's he would have his firearm in the back and if something were to happen, he would try to defuse the situation by talking them down and if that did not work, then he would removed them from the bar.

HARDWICK stated he would be there as security, as well as a bartender for the night.

I informed HARDWICK that if he had problems, to contact the police. Heft him my card with the district number, as well as a cell number that is being used for the night and that if something happens or if something is about to happen, to call the police and let us help the bar. I informed HARDWICK that the agent would have to explain to the license committee why the doors are locked and a buzzer is used to open the door. HARDWICK stated he understood.

HARDWICK stated he would call the police if needed and welcomed us into the bar during the night on New Year's.

This report is written by P.O. Nicolas FERRANTE, assigned to District 5, Late Shift.

On Friday, April 17 at approximately 1:05 AM while on routine patrol, my partner (P.O. SLUKA) and I observed 4 subjects exiting Rose's Place a tavern located at 2878 N 20th St located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI. Due to the Governor Ever's current safer at home order, and this business not holding a food vendor license or signage offering any type of food delivery or pick-up we performed a Business Check (BC-C.)

It should also be noted that there were 3 vehicles parked within close proximity of this tavern on the street.

The front door the business was locked upon our arrival, after knocking a William PHILLIPS (B/M 9-29-71), who identified himself as the manager answered the door. PHILIPS was cooperative throughout the business check, and provided all information needed. PHILLIPS initially stated that it was only him and 1 employee in the bar doing "some cleaning." I asked PHILLIPS if he would allow us to enter inside the premise and he allowed us in, with no issue.

Inside the tavern my partner and I observed fully inflated balloons, throughout the bar. It appeared to be as if the bar was cleaning up after throwing a party. At this point PHILLIPS did state to my partner and I he did have a "couple" people in the bar earlier prior to our arrival. PHILLIPS was able to provide me with all licenses issued and they were posted above the bar and fully visible.

At this point I advised PHILLIPS that due to his business being considered non essential, he should abide by the current Governors safer at home order. PHILLIPS states he understands this, and will not allow patrons in the bar again.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 11/10/2020 at 11:40 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
