

Re: Report of the Renewal Application of Moranda R. Johnson for a Public Passenger

Vehicle Driver License.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Moranda R. Johnson (hereinafter the "Licensee") is the holder of a Public Passenger 1. Vehicle Driver License in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Said license expired at midnight, September 30, 2020.
- 2. An application to renew said license was filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
- 3. On November 4, 2020, the City Clerk's Office provided timely notice to the Licensee, pursuant to Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and § 349.24 of the Wisconsin Statutes, of a police report that could form the basis for suspension or nonrenewal of the license and included therewith a copy of the Milwaukee Police Department report. The matter was scheduled for a hearing on the police report on November 11, 2020 at approximately 10:00 a.m. in Room 301-B of City Hall. At said date, time and place, the licensee did not appear.
- 4. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following:
 - A. Notice was sent to Moranda R. Johnson at 4203 North 39th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53216, along with a copy of the police report on November 4, 2020 in an envelope which was sent by U.S. first-class prepaid mail in an envelope bearing the return address of the License Division, 200 East Wells Street, Room 105, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202. The address of 4203 North 39th Street. Milwaukee, WI 53216 was the address given by the applicant on her renewal application. The licensee did not appear at the hearing and the envelope containing the notice and police report was not returned to the License Division by the U.S. Postal Service.



B. Alderman Borkowski moved denial based on Licensee's second nonappearance. (Prevailed 5-0)

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provide Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and § 349.24, Wisconsin Statutes.
- 2. Based upon the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the licensee, Moranda R. Johnson, has not met the criteria of Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances or § 349.24 of the Wisconsin Statutes to allow renewal of her Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License based upon her second nonappearance.
- 3. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Public Safety Committee that the full Common Council of the City of Milwaukee should exercise its judgment to not renew the Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License held by Moranda R. Johnson based upon her second nonappearance.

RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee recommends by a vote of five (5) ayes, and zero (0) noes that the Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License of Moranda R. Johnson be denied based upon her second nonappearance.
