The objective for this operational plan are to decrease the incidence of targeted driving violations, related crashes and to increase voluntary compliance with traffic regulations thereby decreasing fatalities and serious injury collisions by way of a proactive and highly visible enforcement effort. Officers involved in the campaign will take a zero-tolerance on the following violations: a) impaired driving violations, b) operating while intoxicated/impaired, and c) occupant restraint violations. The main purpose of this grant is for the enforcement of operating under the influence by motor vehicle operators.

This Grant Project aims to develop a multi-jurisdictional Traffic Safety task force geared towards decreasing traffic crashes and obtaining voluntary compliance with traffic regulations.
