

## 1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The objectives for this operational plan are to decrease the incidence of fatalities and serious injuries resulting from motor vehicle crashes by enforcing seat belt usage in Milwaukee. Through high visibility enforcement, Milwaukee Police Department — in partnership with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Department and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee Police Department — will enforce all occupant restraint laws to encourage seat belt use. As part of this grant, the Milwaukee Police Department will adopt a zero-tolerance policy towards impaired driving and unrestrained occupants during all motor vehicle stops; MPD will also maintain or exceed historical activity levels (rate of traffic stops during deployments) during grant-funded activity.

# 2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

This grant falls within the purview of the department's aim to decrease fatalities, serious injuries, and long-term disabilities by increasing compliance with safety restraint laws and promoting public safety.
