Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. This report was submitted by PO Brett Stegerwald. I am currently assigned to District 4, Early Shift, Squad 4227 with PO Shane Doughty.

On 3/18/20, PO Doughty and I were asked by acting D4 Shift Commander Sgt. Federer, to conduct a License Premise Check at the address of 8762 N Granville Rd. A citizen called in stating that Irie Palace Bar and Grill has been open the last two nights, and is violating the state wide mandate due to the novel Covid-19 virus.

PO Doughty and arrived on scene at approximately 6:24 pm. I immediately observed 8-10 vehicles parked in the parking lot to Irie Palace, and an "open" LED sign in the front window. I observed patrons to the business out back smoking cigarettes also.

Upon making entrance into the business, I observed multiple people inside the bar. I observed multiple people with drinks sitting in front of them. I observed two people playing billiards, whom also had drinks in a glass jar, along with empty plates, and it appeared they had just ate inside inside the Irie Palace.

Shortly after walking in, almost all of the patrons inside Irie Palace, left the bar. PO Doughty and I asked if the owner or manager of the bar was, and Patrick D Hudson (b/m,8/24/66) stated he was the manager. Hudson is also the business agent for Irie Palace.

PO Doughty spoke to Hudson about the state wide mandate, and provided him a copy of the rules and regulations that are put in place right now, due to the Covid-19 flu. PO Doughty advised Hudson that nobody should be in the bar, and that if they order food, it should be for take out only, and the customers, should only come in to pay, and pick up their food. PO Doughty advised Hudson that after the customers pay for their food, they should wait in their car for a short amount of time, and to only come back inside when the food is ready for pick up.

Hudson stated he was only advised by the news of the temporary "no dining in" restrictions. Hudson denied serving any alcohol since this state wide mandate was implemented. Hudson stated people were only drinking juice, water, and red bulls.

Hudson was advised that a continued failure to adhere by the state mandated rules, could potentially result in loss of his license, and a potential fine. I advised Hudson we would be continuously following

up with bars/restaurants in the area to make sure they are following all temporary rules and regulations.

Hudson was extremely cooperative, and stated he would follow the rules from this point out. Hudson was provided a copy of the current food/restaurant regulations in place, and was advised to contact the district if he had any questions or concerns.

I spoke to the manager/bartender Romiesha M Rhodes (b/f,8/27/91) and also advised her of the currently regulations, and she also stated no alcohol has been being served. Rhodes was advised of the best way to serve customers the take out food, and limit how long people are inside of the Irie Palace. Rhodes Bartender License number is 0230803.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 12/1/2020 at 10:10 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
