Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation nit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 01/07/09 at 1:08 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 8214 W Keefe Avenue for a Theft complaint. Officers spoke to the victim who stated an unknown person stole her wallet out of her purse as she sat at the bar. Officers did speak with the bartender who stated she was informed about the lost wallet. A report was filed.
- 2. On 03/20/2014 Milwaukee police were dispatched to an Aggravated Battery complaint at 3717 North 76th Street (Schneider's Food and Drink). Investigation revealed two female patrons became involved in an argument, culminating in one patron striking the other in the head with a glass mug. The victim sustained an injury requiring stitches. Milwaukee police incident report # 140790018 filed.
- 3. On 09/04/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight complaint at 3717 North 76th Street. Investigation revealed a patron of the business became loud and boisterous, threatening the bartender. The patron was cited.

4. On 01/31/2020 at 1:52am an officer observed several cars in the parking lot of Schneider's Tavern, 3717 N. 76th St. At 2:00am the officer observed 2 patrons exit the bar with open beer bottles. The officer had the subjects empty the bottles and at 2:04am entered the tavern and found approximately 15 patrons inside. The patrons left and the officer spoke with the bartender, who stated she was working alone and could not get the patrons to leave. The applicant arrived while the officers were on scene and was advised he would receive a warning and future violations would result in a citation.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by Police Officer Andrew WILKIEWICZ, assigned to District 7, Late Power Shift.

On Friday, January 31, 2020, at approximately 1:52 A.M., Squad 7468 (Police Officer Anna KULENOVIC and I) observed approximately 20 vehicles in the parking lot of Schneider's Tavern located at 3717 N. 76th St.

I pulled into the parking lot and observed the tavern for a few minutes knowing that the tavern was required to be closed by 2:00 A.M. At approximately 2:00 A.M. I observed 2 patrons exit the tavern observed that both patrons had open beer bottles that contained beer in their possession in the parking lot of the tavern. I asked the patrons to dump out their beers and exit the premises.

P.O. KULENOVIC and I entered the tavern at 2:04 A.M. and observed approximately 15 patrons still inside the tavern. All of the patrons were exiting the tavern as I was entering the premise.

I spoke to the bartender, Jannel R. POPP (W/F, 3/10/91), and asked her why patrons were in the tavern after 2:00 A.M. POPP stated that she was the only employee working and was unable to have them exit the tavern by 2:00 A.M. I informed POPP that when the tavern was busier, she needed to make the last call earlier and stop serving earlier so the patrons can exit the tavern on time. I informed POPP that I would issue her a warning for having patrons in the tavern after hours as this was the first violation I have observed at the tavern.

As I was exiting the tavern, the owner, Lenny CHU (A/M, 2/28/57), arrived on scene and I was able to speak with CHU regarding the incident. I informed CHU of the incident and reminded CHU that he holds the Class B Tavern License and is ultimately responsible for all aspects of the tavern and that future violations could result in the issuance of citations.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 12/1/2020 at 9:20 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
