The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/11/2004 at 5:20 PM the applicant was cited for Sale to Underage at 601 E Bolivar Av. No further information.

2. On 06/25/2005 at 9:46PM officers responded to the licensed premises at 601 E Bolivar regarding a disturbance involving 15 juveniles. The complainant related that there were 15 juveniles drinking and causing a disturbance. Upon arrival officers observed some of the juveniles run into the back yard of the tavern. Officers also observed juveniles run into the back door of the tavern. The bartender on the scene, Eileen BRATEL, the ex-wife of the applicant, appeared to be intoxicated herself. She yelled at officers saying they had no business in the back hall of the tavern. Further investigation revealed that 8-juveniles had been drinking. All were cited. The bartender was taken into custody after she attempted to hit one of the investigating officers with an object she retrieved from behind the bar. The bartender continued to yell and swear at officers as she was escorted out of the tavern. The applicant, who was out of town was contacted. He related that the bartender was his ex-wife for a reason. That her mouth was always getting her into trouble and that she thinks she is above the law.

- 3. On 03/28/2020 officers conducted a license premise check at Gator's Pub, 601 E. Bolivar Av, regarding complaints at the business for violations of the Governor's emergency orders. The officers located the wife of the owner inside the business. The applicant was also on scene and stated the business is open for carry out only. The officer spoke with the caller who stated there were 4-5 people inside prior to the officer's arrival.
- 4. On 07/22/2020 officers conducted a license premise check at Gator's Pub, 601 E. Bolivar Av, regarding complaints the business was over serving patrons. The officer talked with the bartender, who stated she does not serve people she believes has had too much to drink. The applicant was on scene and stated that some of his regular patrons are elderly and have trouble walking so they may have been mistaken for being over served.

On Saturday, March 28th, 2020 at 1:37 PM, I was dispatched to 601 E. Bolivar Av (Gator's Pub) for a BCC (Business Check) in the City and County of Milwaukee. Sqd 6111, Sgt FLORES and 6152 (PO's GRACZYK, MARSHALL) also responded.

The caller KANISTY, Nancy A (W/F, 4-13-46) who lives at 608 E. Bolivar Av, #414-333-9221, called making a complaint of patrons inside the bar (Gator's Pub) and approximately 4 cars outside.

Upon arrival, I did not observe any vehicles parked in front of location or across the street. I entered the establishment and was greeted by BRATEL, Eileen E (W/F, 10-18-59) who was the only person inside.

I spoke with Eileen who stated people stop in for carry out and then leave the establishment. Eileen stated her husband BRATEL, Dennis D (W/M, 7-6-54) is the owner/license holder and is on the premise.

At this point Dennis entered the main area of the bar through a back door. I spoke with Dennis who stated they sell food and beer as carry out only.

Dennis stated the hours of operations for now are Monday-Friday 1p-5p, Saturday-Sunday 1p-3p.

I called Nancy who stated someone must of tipped off the bar, because there was 4-5 people inside the bar for approximately 30 minutes and left in a hurry before police arrived. Nancy stated there are always people inside the bar.

I advised Nancy a report will be filed regarding her complaints.

This report is written by P.O. Joel BUNKELMAN, assigned to District 6, Late Power shift, squad 6468.

On Wednseday, July 22nd, 2020, P.O. Jason WALLICH and I conducted a "Tavern Check" at Gator's PUB, located at 601 E Bolivar AV, in the city and county of Milwaukee. The tavern check was conducted at the request of P.O. Fabian GARCIA. P.O. GARCIA received an email from Jennifer UTTKE. UTTKE resides at 4528 S. Adams AV. UTTKE stated that she was concerned that the establishment was over serving their patrons. She stated that on two different occasions she has seen two male subjects stumbling out of the bar.

I spoke with the bartender on duty, Ashley L DAHLKE (w/f 10-9-87). I advised DAHLKE of the concern from the UTTKE. DAHLKE stated that she does not serve people who she believes have had too much. She also stated that she has and will continue to cut people off that she feels have had too much to drink. I did also check DAHLKE'S bartenders license which was current and valid.

Prior to us leaving the establishment I was stopped by the agent and owner of the bar, Dennis BRATEL (w/m 7-6-54). BRATEL stated that the hours for the bar are 8am to 10pm everyday. He states that they try to be conscious of the neighborhood and try to remain quite and low key. I advised BRATEL of the issue that the establishment was being accused of. He stated that they do their best to not over serve patrons. He did state that some of his regular patrons are elderly and have trouble walking so they may have confused that for people being over served.

There have been 4 calls for service at the location since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic. All the complaints were either baseless or the establishment was in compliance. There has also been 2 tavern checks done and both times the establishment was in compliance.

Both parties I spoke with were kind and courteous during my interaction with them. The entire interaction was captured on my Axon Body worn camera.

This concludes this report.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 12/1/2020 at 11:05 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
