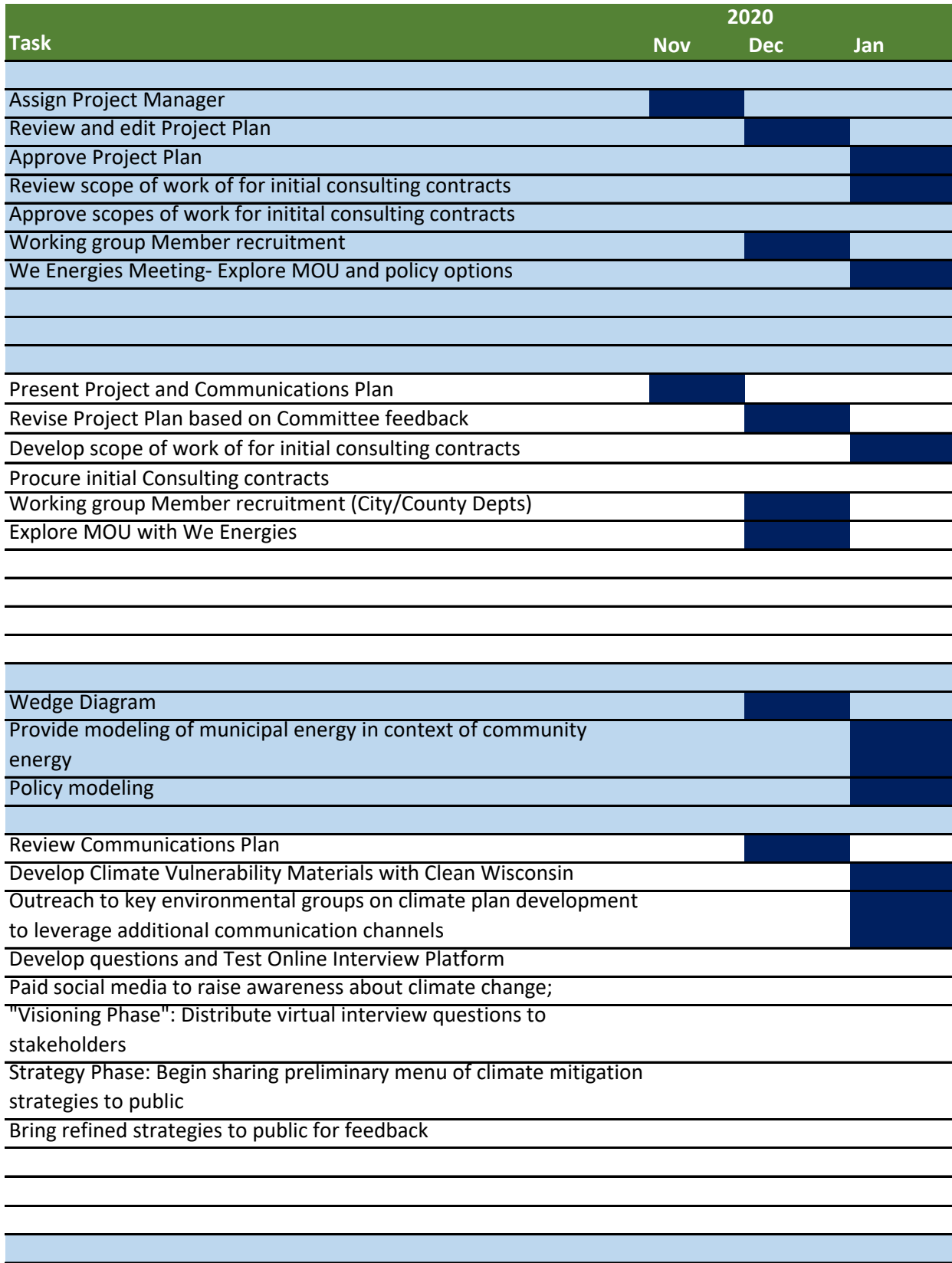

Review US Department of Energy and Labor Green Job Pathways, and identify local training providers and barriers to people of color	
Work plans and streamlined pathways proposed with local workforce investment board, trade unions, technical college, or other workforce partners; narrow focus area to key occupations

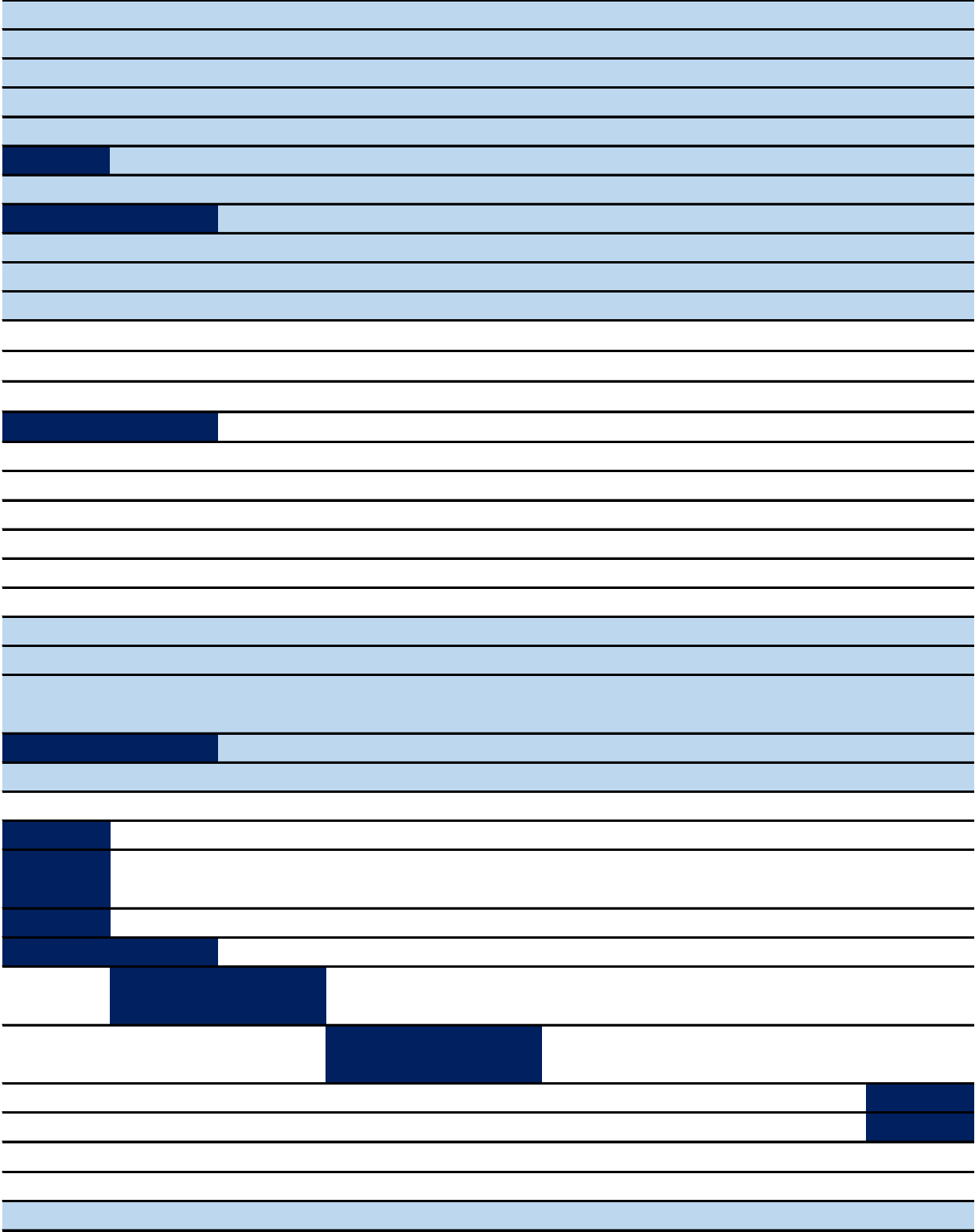
