PERSONNEL ORDER 2020 - 138

RE: DISCIPLINARY ACTION

POLICE OFFICER BALBIR C. MAHAY, (014767), Sixth District, charged with violation of department Core Values as follows:


Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.05, referencing Standard Operating Procedures relating to Vehicle Pursuits and Emergency Vehicle Operations, Section 660.35(A)(2): Failure to exercise due regard while engaged in the emergency operation of a department vehicle.

The charge having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Failure to exercise due regard
while engaged in the emergency

Twelve (12) day suspension
without pay and re-training in
Emergency Vehicle Operations.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER BALBIR C. MAHAY be suspended for twelve (12) working days without pay. If not appealed, said suspension shall be served during the following periods: January 18, 2021 through January 27, 2021; and February 8, 2021 through February 11, 2021. It is further hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER BALBIR C. MAHAY receive re-training in Emergency Vehicle Operations.
