## PERSONNEL ORDER NO. 2020 - 142

December 9, 2020

### RE: MODIFICATION OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION


POLICE OFFICER DONALD S. ANTONIAK, (010723), appealed his total seven (7) day suspension without pay for violation of the following Department Core Values: Core Value 5.00 - Respect, referencing Guiding Principle 5.01: Failure to treat a member of the public with courtesy and professionalism; and Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.05, referencing Standard Operating Procedures relating to Personnel Investigations, Section 450.10(B): Failure to refer a citizen making a complaint to a supervisor (Personnel Order No. 2020-03, promulgated on January 7, 2020) to the Fire and Police Commission.

ACTING CHIEF OF POLICE MICHAEL J. BRUNSON has agreed to reduce the penalty for the violation of department Code of Conduct, Core Value 5.00 - Respect, referencing Guiding Principle 5.01: Failure to treat a member of the public with courtesy and professionalism, from a three (3) day suspension without pay, to a two (2) day suspension without pay and remedial training in Professional Communications. POLICE OFFICER DONALD S. ANTONIAK unequivocally agrees to the two (2) day suspension without pay and remedial training in Professional Communications.

Further, ACTING CHIEF OF POLICE MICHAEL J. BRUNSON has agreed to reduce the penalty for the violation of Department Code of Conduct, Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.05, referencing Standard Operating Procedures relating to Personnel Investigations, Section 450.10(B): Failure to refer a citizen making a complaint to a supervisor, from a four (4) day suspension without pay, to a two (2) day suspension without pay. POLICE OFFICER DONALD S. ANTONIAK unequivocally agrees to the two (2) day suspension without pay.

POLICE OFFICER DONALD S. ANTONIAK heretofore completed the above-referenced remedial training relative to Professional Communications on January 22, 2020.

Accordingly, it is hereby ordered that the total seven (7) day suspension without pay imposed pursuant to Personnel Order 2020-03 shall be reduced to a total four (4) day suspension without pay. Said suspension shall be served during the following period: February 5, 2021 through February 10, 2021.
