| Proposal                | Erect a solar array of 858 ground-mounted panels on long-vacant land on the Wgema/Concordia College Campus.  |  |
| Staff comments          | The land in question has been vacant since the early 1970s when housing was demolished to create a running track and athletic field for Concordia College. It is unclear when the paved running track was removed.<br>In consultation with the Department of City Development, as required by the ordinance, it would be inappropriate to conduct a full review of an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness at this time. The proposed use requires an amendment to the planned development. When new construction in a historic district requires an amendment to a planned development, the city's preservation ordinance requires joint review of the amendment by the Commission and the Department of City Development and encourages a joint meeting with the City Plan Commission (MCO 320-21-11-i). As a zoning amendment application has not been filed, this joint meeting cannot yet be scheduled. It is preferable to conduct the joint meeting because the approval of both bodies is required, and joint deliberation would streamline the process. |  |
