ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

This report is written by Police Officer Michael WARD. On this day I was assigned to Squad 6264 with Police Officer Fabian GARCIA.

On November 20th, 2020, we conducted a CPTED survey at 3511 S. 20th St., Wilson Park Liquor. Future new owner and agent, Gagandeep Singh SRAN (A/M, 12-25-1989) was present during the time of the survey.

Recommendations and observations made:

1. Safe is located in the breakroom bolted to the floor but unsecured. Advised to keep safe secured at all times. Also advised adding a door that can be secured for the breakroom. Currently just a curtain separates break room and sales floor.

- 2. Signage on exterior windows blocks view in to store. Advised signage and large shelf in front of window be removed to have better sight lines into the store. While on scene some of the signage was removed.
- 3. Basement is used for storage. Advised to put an adequate lock on door to prevent customers going down stairs.
- 4. ATM located in the store near entrance.

Register counter is surrounded with plexi glass and has a door which secures from the inside.

Mr. SRAN was receptive to our recommendations and was advised this survey would be submitted.




City Concentration Map 3511 S 20th ST

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
