Dear Common Council Members:


We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

On July 29, 2020, a water meter technician conducted a meter exchange at 3884 N. 7th Street. During the process, the technician operated the inlet and outlet valves in order to turn off the water. While turning off the inlet Ground Key Stop valve, the core nut broke off causing water pressure in the pipe to force off the valve, resulting in water to flow inside the residence.

The technician was able to turn off the water from the curb stop to stop the flow of water coming into the residence. Heiden Plumbing was hired to cut the lead line and add a new shut off valve. It is Milwaukee Water Work's position the claimant's property was damaged as a result of the water meter technician's repair activity.

Ms. Cynthia Pinto, property owner of 3884 N. 7th Street, acquired the services of ServPro to pump water out of the basement, clean the floors, sanitize, and removed all the debris. Ms. Pinto also incurred damages to her personal property.

Ms. Pinto has filed a claim against the City for \$12,701.85, which is consisted of a final bill from ServPro in the amount of \$9,478.98, and a list of damaged personal property in the amount of \$3,222.87. A compromise settlement of \$10,000 was extended for full and

final settlement of her claim. We recommend the Common Council approve settlement of this matter for \$10,000 in exchange for a signed and notarized release from Ms. Pinto.
