

NEW \$30,000 HOME TO BE BUILT BY A. J. LINDEMANN

Site Is at Intersection of Bradford
and Wahl Avenues, Opposite Caleb
Johnson Home.

A new dwelling to cost upward of \$30,000 is about to be erected on the lake front at the intersection of Bradford and Wahl avenues by A. J. Lindemann of Lindemann & Hoverson, stove manufacturers.

The design, by Architect Fitzhugh Scott, is to be of the English villa type. Across the street is Caleb Johnson's magnificent Italian villa. The interior arrangement, substance of construction and date for beginning the work are yet indefinite.

The property, which was purchased from Richard Houghton, president of the Wilbur Lumber company of this city and a resident of Nashotah, has a 110

foot frontage toward the lake and is 120 feet deep, and was purchased at a price, it is said, of \$30,000.
