REASON FOR REQUEST:

Antonio Santos, a City of Milwaukee DPW employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a city vehicle that was traveling northbound on North 17th Street at a very low rate of speed while a co-worker stood outside the rear of the truck shoveling asphalt from the bed of the truck and filling potholes. The uninsured motorist, who was traveling northbound on North 17th Street at a high rate of speed, failed to yield the right away and rear-ended the City dump truck, pinning the co-worker between the vehicles. Prior to being taken to the emergency room for his own injuries, Mr. Santos attempted to help save the co-worker, who unfortunately passed away at the scene. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Santos sustained injuries to his head, neck, back and a psychological injury. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$25,982.53.
