
5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

On the East Side of The Church, right above the gutters, the existing terra cotta clay tile will be removed every 2', and replaced with a custom fabricated aluminum Spanish tile. The tile will be equipped with brackets to support the pipe system. A triple section of piping will be installed and connected through the custom brackets. The aluminum piping will be in a color to match the roof.

Every winter and Spring, during the freeze and thaw, ice falls onto the parking lot / pedestrian areas, and is a safety issue. On Wednesday, January 6, 2021, the weight of the falling ice severely damaged an exterior canopy. It has since been removed.
