3. On 05/10/16, Milwaukee police conducted follow up regarding a referral from the Heath

Department for the Convenience Store Robbery Deterrence Safety training. Officers spoke with Rana Anwar and he stated he was aware of the next class that was scheduled for July 7th,

5. On 08/11/18 at 10:15am a 17 year old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police Department and WI WINS Tobacco initiative, was able to purchase a 2 pack of Black and Mild Cigars at 406 W. Center Street, The sales clerk admitted to selling the item, but stated he only looked at the birth year on the drivers license. The station was mailed a MARTS enrollment

packet.

6. On 12/27/19 at 6:21pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 406 W. Center Street. While inside the establishment, officers could smell, and see, cigarette smoke inside and observed cigarette ashes in a potato chip box next to products that were for sale. The station has four electronic slot machines that patrons smoke at while playing which was observed by officers while they were watching earlier security footage. Officers also found marijuana, packaged in small baggies for individual sale, inside a jacket that was left abandoned by the slot machines.

7. On 12/23/19 at 6:18pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 406 W. Center Street for a subject with gun complaint. The complaint stated that there were a bunch of subjects at that location and one of them was waving a gun and other subjects were selling drugs and were located by the slot machines. No firearm was located.

8. On 01/21/20 at 12:21pm, Milwaukee Police along with Special Agent Georgeann KING of Wisconsin Alcohol & Tobacco, and Special Enforcement Inspector Lori GALLUP, conducted a compliance investigation at the location of 406 W. Center St. The investigation was regarding drug complaints, customers smoking in the location, and loitering panhandling issues. The business agent, Rana ANWAR was at the location during the investigation. Officers contributed the main factor to the complaints, being 4 electronic gambling machines in the lobby of the gas station. Officers located cigarette butts on the floor, throughout the gas station. Also there was a significant amount of cigarette butts, and ash near the gambling machines. Agent KING located several tobacco products in the gas station's inventory that were not properly purchased. Inspector GALLUP addressed the expired occupancy permit, issued an order for the public restroom to be repaired, and then reopened. Investigators found a currency disbursement receipt from one of the gambling machines. Agent KING did order the agent to remove the gambling machine under Wisconsin Statues after it was determined that the machines were not being used for novelty entertainment purposes. Officers informed the business agent that subjects are loitering in the lobby, playing the machines and using that as

a cover to sell drugs. The agent was cooperative and stated the machines are owned and controlled by ATS Novelties LLC, and will consider removing them.

- 9. On 02/17/20 at 12:35 pm Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 406 W. Center Street. Officers observed four gambling machines in the front lobby part of the gas station. Officers spoke with the cashier on scene who stated that the gas station pays out on the machines and showed officers receipts from the machines. Officers looked over the current licenses of the gas station and discovered an entertainment license was not issued by the city, regarding the gambling machines. The agent Rana ANWAR was notified regarding the violations and issued citations.
- 10. On 02/28/20 at 10:20pm Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 406 W. Center Street. Officers observed two subjects operating two of the four gambling machines in the front lobby. The subjects were instructed by officer to stop using the machines, and to leave the gas station, which they complied. Officers continued with the premise check and located near a rack of chips a clear Tupperware container with numerous multicolored pills. Officers suspected the pills to be ecstasy and the pills were later tested positive for Methamphetamine. Officers were informed that the gas station has had previous complaints of subjects selling drugs, and smoking in the store. The suspects would use the gambling machines to be at the location and conceal contraband with in the chip racks. Officers were allowed to review video and observed the two subjects being in the store for over a hour playing the gambling machines. Officers had knowledge from a license committee on 02/19/19 that the gambling machines were not to operated, and a violation of the business plan. The gambling machines could not be operated without an entertainment license through the city. It was confirmed through the online licensing system that a PEP license was not located or applied for. Officers order the clerk to shut down the machines, which he complied. The agent was later contacted and issued a citation regarding the gambling machines.
- 11. On 03/05/20 at 11:52pm Milwaukee Police conducted a canvass at 406 W. Center St, regarding a shots fired complaint at 2719 N. Vel R. Phillips St. Officers spoke with the gas station clerk who stated that he did not see or hear anything regarding the incident. The clerk allowed officers to review video surveillance. Officers discovered that the incident occurred in the parking lot of the gas station. The video revealed the victim's vehicle parked near two gas pumps. The suspect exits his vehicle and conducts a hand to hand transaction with the victim. The suspect vehicle then moves towards the east entrance, stops the vehicle, suspects then exits his vehicle to open the truck. The victim exits his vehicle then approaches the suspect and begins to fight with the suspect outside the vehicle. The victim's vehicle then moves to the front of the suspect vehicle by a female driver. The female drivers exits the victim's vehicle and talks to the suspect and victim fighting. Both parties then get in their vehicles. From his vehicle the suspect fires three gun shots at the victim's auto. The suspect auto then exits west bound from the location. The victim sustained a single gunshot to his stomach.
- 12. On 07/27/20 at approximately 8:17am Milwaukee Police checked at 406 W. Center St for a scene regarding a shooting complaint. The gas station clerk allowed officers to review video surveillance. From Camera # 3 officers observed the suspect, and the suspect vehicle a tan/beige 2000's Dodge Caravan with no plates. From the camera footage officers observed the victim pull into the gas station in his vehicle, and begin to pump gas. A short time later the suspect vehicle moves towards the victim, and the suspect exits the passenger side of the suspect vehicle. The suspect and the victim engage in a conversation outside near the victim's vehicle. The victim is then seen hobbling away from the location eastbound. The suspect then goes through the victim's vehicle before returning to his vehicle. The suspect then leaves the location in the suspect auto with an unknown driver. The victim returns to his vehicle and

leaves the gas station driving southbound. Officers recovered one spent casing near the gas pumps.

13. On 12/19/20 at 9:56pm Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 406 W. Center St. Officers observed four gambling machines along the east wall of the gas station. Officers spoke with the gas station clerk who stated that the machines have not been in use and had them unplugged. The clerk was asked by officers why the machines were still in the store if they were not in use, the clerk did not have an answer regarding. Officers did observe an amusement license on the gambling machines expired May of 2020. Officers did not observe or locate an entrainment license with the city for the machines. Officers contacted the agent regarding the license check, and confirmed that no application or license was in LIRA.

This report is submitted by P.O. Chauncey Harris assigned to the District 5 Community Prosecution Unit. On Tuesday, 1-21-2020 at 12:21 pm, I, my partner P.O. Michael Driscoll, P.O. Dana Rebro and P.O. Keith Garland responded to 406 W. Center Street to assist State of Wisconsin Alcohol and Tobacco Special Agent Georgeann KING with a business compliance investigation. District 5 officers had received several complaints from citizens and community groups about this location. Numerous complaints were reported regarding people loitering inside and outside and selling drugs. We also received complaints of people smoking tobacco inside the store. District 5 Officers along with District 5 Community Prosecution Officers determined the location had 4 electronic gambling machines inside the lobby which we determined were the main contributing factor for subjects loitering in the lobby at all times of the day. I conducted a business check a week prior to this investigation to observe these behaviors. During that business check I located discarded cigarette buts on the floor. Upon our arrival we did close the location for Agent KING to conduct her investigation. Officers did locate cigarette buts on the floor and on the gambling machines. There was a significant amount of cigarette ash on the machines as well. Shortly after our arrival the manager Rana F. ANWAR arrived and was cooperative with the investigations. A license check determined the City of Milwaukee Occupancy permit for the location was expired since 1-22-17. Agent KING also located several tobacco products in ANWARs' inventory that were not properly purchased.

Also along with us was Special Enforcement Inspector Lori GALLUP who did address the expired occupancy permit and issued a order for the public restroom to be repaired and reopened for use. The clerk working at the time Paramjit SINGH did show a P.O. Driscoll a currency disbursement receipt from one of the machines. Agent KING did instruct ANWAR to remove the gambling machines per Wisconsin State Statutes after determination the machines are paying out money. ANWAR stated the machines are owned and controlled by ATS Novelties LLC. I did observe a City of Milwaukee License on one of the machines (Lic# ADIST 0198311 exp. 6-30-20) with the listed agent Guy J. STARZ N69 W 23426 Salem Ct, Sussex, WI 53089.

We informed ANWAR subjects are loitering in the lobby and playing the machines and using that as a cover to sell drugs and panhandle, to avoid being targeted by officers. ANWAR stated he would consider removing the machines. Agent King did seize several various brands of tobacco products from the location due to non-compliance with revenue reporting and purchasing guidelines. MPD officers have been proactive with addressing drug loitering complaints and have made drug arrest regarding the

This report is being submitted by PO Xavier BENITEZ assigned to the License Investigation Unit. On Monday February 17th, 2020 at 12:35 pm PO Penny MONREAL and I conducted a license premise check at 406 W. Center St (BP Gas Station) I was equipped with an Axon worn body camera at the time of the license premise check. To view the interaction in it's entirely please review Axon camera footage.

During the walk through of the premise it was discovered that four gambling gaming machines with phone charging cables were towards the front of the store. Officers continued to the cashier area, and spoke with Paramjit NMN SINGH (m/w 05-12-86) the employee at the store. I looked over the displayed licenses and it was discovered that the business did not have an entertainment license with the city, regarding the machines. SINGH stated to officers that the machines are paid out daily. When a customer with receipt comes with a pay amount he pays it instantly. SINGH also showed officers a drawer full of paid out receipts from the machines.

SINGH was given officers contact information and informed that officers would be in contact with the agent.

This license premise report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5 Late Power Shift, with PO Russell MACRAE.

On 02-28-20 we were informed by other officers that the video gambling machines inside of 406 W. Center St., were operating. The officers were asking if we wanted to know about this, so we could a license check of the establishment.

At 10:20 p.m., we conducted a license inspection of the business. 406 W. Center St., is a BP Gas Station. Upon entering the business we observed the 4 video gambling machines turned on and two people, one standing and one sitting, playing the machines. We instructed the two to stop playing the machines and leave the gas station, which they did.

After a few minutes, PO MACRAE located in a rack of chips, a small clear plastic Tupperware type of container, with a purple lid, which contained numerous multicolored pills, which appeared to be suspected ecstasy. Upon returning to District 5, counted were 33 pills of various colors, which tested positive for Methamphetamine.

While we were there, PO RAMION and PO WANGER arrived and helped us at the gas station. We were informed that people who play the machines sell narcotics out of the gas station, while playing the machines. They have located in the past, drugs as well as firearms in the chip racks, mixed in with the chips. I was also informed that the public bathroom always has burnt ashes scattered around the bathroom. I was taken to the bathroom, where I observed burnt ashes in the sink.

PO MACRAE watched the store video and it showed the two individuals we observed upon arriving, they were at the store for about an hour playing the video machines.

PO MACRAE informed the clerk to turn off the gambling machines prior to our leaving. The clerk has the ability to use a master switch and turn the power on and off to the machines, from inside of the cashier area.

Prior to going to the location, PO MACRAE and I watched the license meeting from 02-19-20, where the agent Rana ANWAR appeared. The video gambling machines was talked about and ANWAR was informed by the committee that it was a violation of their business plan. ANWAR was also informed that even though the distributor of the machines needs a license for the machines, the business needs a

Public Entertainment License as well for the machines. ANWAR was informed by the committee that if the machines were to remain in the business, that they remain unplugged.

Prior to this committee meeting, LIU went to the establishment and cited the business for the use of the gambling machines. At that time, the business was informed by LIU officers to not use the machines and get the proper licensing.

I checked the online licensing system to see if there was a Public Entertainment License (PEP) and did not locate any PEP license or application.

I am citing ANWAR for operating the machines, without a PEP license.

This report is written by P.O. Robert WATTS, assigned to District Five, Late Power Shift.

On Thursday, March 5th 2020, I (PO Robert WATTS) was assigned to Squad 5490. I was operating a marked black and white Milwaukee Police Department wagon equipped with red/blue emergency lights and audible siren. I was in full MPD uniform with badge and nameplate affixed to my outermost garment. I was equipped with a body worn camera, which was activated and captured this incident.

On 03/05/20 at approximately 11:52 PM, I was dispatched to a shots fired call at 2719 N Vel R. Phillips St. Upon arrival I searched the immediate area. While on scene I spoke to the BP gas station clerk, Jassi SINGH (W/M, 10/08/83) who stated he was inside of the service station tending to customers and did not see or hear anything regarding this incident. SINGH allowed me to check video surveillance and I observed the incident which occurred in the BP parking lot.

While on scene I observed an orange Dodge Charger park near the 4th pump at the service station. The suspect's vehicle (possible Ford Fusion) parked near the 3rd pump. Suspect exits the driver's side of his vehicle and walks to the passenger side of the victim's vehicle and they conduct a hand to hand transaction. The suspect then gets back into his vehicle and drives toward the east entrance of the gas station, stops his car and opens the trunk. The victim exits the passenger side of the vehicle he was occupying and ran towards the suspect. Both victim and suspect began to wrestle in the parking lot. The vehicle the victim was in then pulls in front of the suspect vehicle and a female gets out of the driver's side. She walks towards both subjects and begins talking. Both subjects separate and they go back to their vehicles. The victim is now on the passenger side of the charger and the suspect drives southbound behind the victim's vehicle. Suspect fires 3 shots striking the victim and exits the BP parking lot at the south side exit heading westbound from the location. The victim's vehicle drives southbound through Center St and continues SB on Vel R Phillips. The victim sustained a single gunshot wound to the stomach.

On Monday. July 27, 2020 while assigned to Squad 5191, myself along with my partner (PO Ashley Navone) were dispatched to 406 W Center St (Center St BP) to check for the scene of a shooting.

Upon arrival we asked gas station staff if we could view the surveillance cameras on the premise to check for possible video of the event.

I was able to access the video from "Camera 3" which faces southeast on to the property and portrayed the incident and the following suspect:

B/M

mid to late 20's

Heavy Build

Black Hair

Red Tshirt with Writing on it

Black or Dark Colored Shorts

Black and White Tennis Shoes

Armed with a possibly silver hand gun

Subject exited a tan or beige 2000's dodge caravan with no plates.

The video depicts the victim pulling up to the gas station in a newer white unknown make/model mini van, facing southbound. The victim exits the van, and begins to pump gas. A short time later, the suspect vehicle pulls up next to the victim vehicle also facing southbound. The suspect vehicle is possibly an older model dodge caravan tan or beige in color with no plates.

The victim is seen engaging in a conversation with the unknown driver. The listed suspect exits the passenger side of the suspect vehicle, walks around the car and engages in some type of unknown conversation with the victim.

The victim is then seen hobbling away eastbound on W. Center St.

Upon speaking with the clerk, Jasvir SINGH, we found that the business had a valid filling station, cig, w&m, 24hrs and food license, all of which are set to expire on 03-19-21.

While there we observed several video gambling machines along the east wall, just to the south of the entrance doors. We have had problems in the past with the business operating these machines and the machines being used by people who were conducting drug sales inside of the business.

SINGH stated the machines have not been in use and showed us that the machines were unplugged, which they were. We asked SINGH why the machines were still inside of the store, if they have not been in used for a long time. SINGH did not have an answer for this. We did observe a copy of a City of Milwaukee Amusement license which expired in May of 2020. The license was listed to Guy J. STARZ (Agent), of ATS Novelties LLC, which is located at N69 W23426 Salem Ct., Sussex WI 53089. We did not observe nor did we locate any current Entertainment or Amusement licenses for the business.

We did contact ANWAR and informed him of our visit and subsequent license report. ANWAR was asked about the gambling machines and he stated that they are through a distributor and that he would have to contact his manager to see if his manager had applied for a license. He stated that he would know if a months time if the machines were going to be used once again, this is why he has not removed them from his business. We checked LIRA and found no applications for public entertainment or amusement license.
