This report is written by Police Officer David Novak, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 05/25/2018 officers observed Fat Valdy's open for business. Knowing the business had been closed by the Health Department on 05/24/2018 the officers conducted a licensed premise check. The manager provided officers with paperwork stating the business had passed the re-inspection that morning and was cleared to reopen.

- 2. On 08/12/2019 officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at Fat Valdy's, 5108 W. Blue Mound Rd. The caller stated she was charged for 7 margaritas but only ordered 5. She stated the business would not remove them and told her to leave and not return. The manager stated the subject was a regular patron and always complained about her bill. She did remove items to get the customer to pay her bill and told her to not return. The officer advised the subject the business did not want her to return and she could be cited for Trespassing if she did return.
- 3. On 02/29/2020 officers were dispatched to a fight at Fat Valdy's, 5108 W. Blue Mound Rd. The officers spoke to an employee, who stated the subjects fighting left prior to the officer's arrival. The staff was cooperative with the officers.





- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
