Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

On Sunday, 1-12-97, at 8:00PM, officers were dispatched to the Newport Lounge located at 1. 939 E Conway Street, for a call for police. Upon arrival, they spoke to licensee, Corne M Hanssen, who stated that he had no idea who called 911. Officers interviewed patrons who stated that there was a fight in the tavern between Hanssen's girl friend and his old girl friend. As officers attempted to obtain more information from the patrons, Hanssen told them not to say anything to police.

- INCIDENT: ---On Friday, 7-12-02, officers were dispatched to "a stabbing" at 1000 E Conway. Investigation revealed that several women were arguing inside the bar over the age of one of the patrons who was believed to not be of legal drinking age, on the licensed premises. Steven Bartaczewicz, who identified himself to investigating officers as the bartender, and acting manager, told the patrons that he had seen a valid Wisconsin identification which instructed all of the people in the area of the argument to leave the premises and go outside. The argument continued outside, and one of the patrons was subsequently stabbed. Offense report filed.
 - 3. On 5-21-2004 at 1:18am police were dispatched to assist an officer call at 5356 S 13th St., Coach's Pub & Grill. Several off duty Milwaukee Police officers intervened in a battery with extremely combative persons in progress at the tavern, and three persons were arrested; each for Disorderly Conduct and Resisting/Obstructing An Officer.
- 4. On 8-17-2004 at 1:27am police were sent to 5356 S 13th, St, Coach's Pub & Grill for a noise nuisance complaint. This was the 2nd call of a noise nuisance complaint for this location on this date.

Regarding the 1st, at 12:22am, the patio door was open that led from the tavern with several people on the patio with a television on. The bartender, Michelle M Medrow-Kielski was informed and advised of the violation. No citation issued. Complaint was satisfied. Regarding the second violation, the complainant stated that the tavern people opened the door again and the noise and the music were causing a disturbance. A citation was issued to the bartender, Medrow-Kielski.

- 5. On 01/04/09 at 2:00 am, Milwaukee police responded to 13th and Edgerton for a Battery complaint. Investigation revealed a patron was kicked out of the bar because the owner Corne Hanssen had reason to believe this patron was smoking marijuana in the bathroom. The patron was angry that he was kicked out and made threats that he was going to come back and shoot up the tavern. The patron, who was interview by police, also made that statement to police and he was then cited for Disorderly Conduct. The battery complaint was found baseless.
- 6. On 08/01/09 at 2:09 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 5356 S 13th Street for a Fight complaint. Officers spoke to the bartender Bethany Davis who stated she did not observe the fight. A witness told police several patrons entered the tavern and had several shots and then asked if they could play darts with him. He agreed and while playing, some of the subjects starting arguing with another patron who was at the bar. These subjects then left the tavern but returned shortly but were escorted out. While leaving, a subject was heard saying, " Latin Kings.. we will be back with a gun and shoot up the place". The licensee Corne Hanssen was not on scene during this incident. Call was advised.

7. On 10/11/09 at 2:30 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 5356 S 13th Street for a Battery complaint. Officers spoke to the victim who stated unknown actors who were inside the tavern attacked him. The victim relayed that the three suspects said something to his girlfriend who did not acknowledge them and they left the bar. While the victim was trying to get into his car, one of the actors starting punching him in the face and body. The victim had a bloody nose and multiple scratches on his face. Officers spoke to the bartender Katie Lepak who stated there were no words exchanged or altercation inside the tavern. Another witness stated that he was told that his "buddy" was being beaten outside and went out there and observed a male punching the victim. Officers were provided video surveillance by the owner Corne Hanssen which showed the three suspects surrounding the victim and striking him about the face and body. Officers arrested the subjects and charged with battery.

- 8. On 05/25/2019 officers were dispatched to Coach's, 5356 S 13th St for a Sick/Injured. The officers met MFD who was on scene with a subject that appeared intoxicated and had fallen down. The subject's daughter arrived and took him home. The officers went home with the subject and helped get him in the house. The daughter stated she has asked the bar to not serve him because it was becoming a problem, but the owner stated "If he doesn't drink here he will drink somewhere". The officers then went back to Coach's and spoke with the applicant, who stated the subject was in the bar when he got there. He saw the subject fall and went to give him aid. He had the bartender call his family to pick him up. The bartender stated she only served him 2 beers and chicken wings. The applicant stated the subject has been a customer for 8 years.
- 9. On 11/18/2019 officers conducted a licensed premise check at Coach's Pub and Grill, 5356 S 13th St. The officer spoke with the bartender, Christopher CASE, who admitted his Class D Operator's license was expired. The officer contacted the owner, who stated CASE had told him he had a Bartending license, but he never confirmed it was valid. The bartender was cited for Bartender's license required and the owner was cited for Responsible Person on Premise Required.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. Joshua YANG, assigned to District Six, Late Power Shift. On Sunday, October 25, 2020, I was assigned to the License Premise Squad (Squad 6468) with P.O. Joel BUNKELMAN.

At approximately 9:02 pm, P.O. BUNKELMAN and I conducted a tavern check at 5356 S. 13th St. (Coach's Pub and Grill), located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, I observed that the signs on the business were illuminated and observed the that the televisions inside were turned on. P.O. BUNKELMAN and I entered through the doors on the south side of the location and I observed that there were no customers inside. I observed that there was only one employee on scene at the time, which was the bartender. I spoke with the bartender who was later identified by Wisconsin driver's license as *Justin D. SKARVAN (W/M, 11/6/90)*. SKARVAN also provided a bartender's license and I observed that the bartender's license had expired on 8/9/20. I asked SKARVAN if he had an updated bartender's license at which time he stated he thought he got some stuff in his email about a temporary license but has not gone to get his fingerprints done. I advised SKARVAN that we would conduct a check to see if he has a bartender's license on file. A check was conducted which revealed that SKARVAN does not have a bartender's license and his application process required his fingerprints to be obtained. I advised SKARVAN that he had to close down during this time due him not having a bartender's license. SKARVAN agreed and began to shut down the bar. SKARVAN was issued a contact card (PF-6). SKARVAN was cooperative but appeared to be upset when he was advised that he had to shut down the bar.

I observed that the tavern license# 207957 was not expired.

P.O. BUNKELMAN spoke with the agent over the phone who was identified as *Corne M. HANSSEN (W/M, 5/20/54)*. P.O. BUNKELMAN advised HANSSEN of the situation at which time he stated he understood and was cooperative.



The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 2/17/2021 at 11:45 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
