The building is a multi-floor property attached to serval other buildings. The business is housed on the third floor which is accessed only through an elevator that is capable of locking out each floor. The business will have a bar, but only operate as a Hall for reserved panned events. The prior business removed the security cameras, but there are plans to install an updated system.


The space was under minor construction at the time of the CPTED and is as described. Once off the elevator there is a bar area and plans for an oval bar with booths and tables on either side of it. The room south of the bar area is an open sapace "hall". West of the bar doors lead to the restroom area and kitchen. A room in the kitchen will be a used as an office / bridal room. There are plans for a small safe, but the agent does not believe there will be much cash transactions, due to events being preplanned and paid for electronically. 
