On Sunday, December 20th, 2020 at approximately 3:16 PM, my partner Police Officer Dorian WHITTENBERGER (Sq: 3271) and I (Sq: 3272) responded to a Shooting complaint at the location of 2485 W. Brown Street, which is in the city and county of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

#### Investigation:

While on scene, a store worker identified as Abdallah I. ISSA (W/M 07/16/1998) stated, while behind the counter an unknown black male entered the store who stated he was having a stroke and to call police. ISSA stated the unknown black male reached into his backpack, retrieved a semi- automatic firearm and he (ISSA) hid behind the counter. ISSA stated a worker who he only knows as, "EARL" began to wrestle the suspect. ISSA stated he then fled out the front of the location and ran to the rear of the building, after hearing one shot from the interior.

ISSA stated he heard banging on the back door and ran to the front of the location and observed "EARL" located on the grass across the street with a gunshot wound to the arm. ISSA stated he did not recognize the suspect and has no other information regarding.

It should be noted, "Earl" was later identified as Leon E. MOFFETT (B/M 04/17/1956) and was the person shot in the arm.

#### **MOFFETT Interview:**

MOFFETT stated he's been at the store for 20 years and an unknown male came in and produced a firearm. MOFFETT stated he wrestled the unknown male and was shot by the firearm in the suspect hand. MOFFETT stated the suspect then fled the location. MOFFETT had no further information.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
