

1. Describe the proposed ordinance or resolution.

The 2020-2021 Wisconsin Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) grant is a continuing grant through the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) through the Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ) ICAC task force. The grant will provide funding for overtime, supplies, and equipment as necessary for investigations and digital forensics to enhance the effectiveness of the task force's response to online child pornography, child exploitation, and child enticement by sexual predators.
