REASON FOR REQUEST:

Alberto Figueroa, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and conducting a traffic stop at 2424 West Capitol Drive. As Officer Figueroa was standing next to the driver side of a vehicle that was stopped facing west on West Capitol Drive, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling westbound on West Capitol Drive at an excessive rate of speed, failed to yield the right of way by deviating from his lane, striking Officer Figueroa. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Figueroa sustained a concussion and injuries to his left leg, left ankle, right hip and ribs. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$277,031.73.
