Settlement Agreement & Consultant

- Settlement Agreement signed by Parties July 23, 2018
 - City of Milwaukee and Plaintiffs' Counsel
- CJI hired in October 2018 to provide technical assistance and data reviews (IV.E.3, IV.A.1, IV.A.3-9)

Overview of Required Reports

- Annual Report published every September
 - Compliance status of all requirements
 - Analysis of encounters as outlined in Agreement
- Six-month report published every March
 - Updated compliance status of non-compliant items only
- Semi-annual analysis
 - Review of IOARS
 - Published in April and October




Annual Report Process

- Delivered to Parties for confidential review, July 23
- Released publicly and filed with Court, September 23
- Presents compliance status, progress, and challenges
- Annual data analysis published starting in September 2020



Semiannual Analysis

Proportion of Encounters and Frisks by Race/Ethnicity

- Analysis of encounters at half year intervals, January - June and July -December
- Three Semiannual Analysis reports released to date
 - February 2020 (Jan-Jun 2019 encounters)
 - June 2020 (Jul-Dec 2019 encounters)
 - September 2020 (Jan-Jun 2020 encounters)

Six-month Follow Up of Annual Report

Released March 23 annually

- Provides updated status and progress on items deemed non-compliant in annual report
- Outlines overall progress and challenges in six month period following latest annual report

Regular Meetings

MPD

- Meeting with primary contact on a weekly basis
- Meeting with broader group of staff on a monthly basis
- Discuss questions and progress on requirements

• FPC

- Meeting with staff on a biweekly basis as needed
- Discuss questions and progress on requirements

- Staff at MPD and FPC drive the meeting agendas
- CJI is available to consult, coach, and provide support



Consultant Activities



- We coordinate closely with Defendants to achieve progress and are in regular contact with:
 - MPD
 - FPC
 - City Attorney's Office Staff and
 - Plaintiffs' Counsel

The Work Ahead

- Assessing compliance with items deemed in-process or non-compliant
- Providing ongoing TA for Fire and Police Commission and MPD
 - Helping them understand, manage from, and communicate findings from the data
- Navigating changes in leadership
- Delivering additional reports in accordance with the Settlement Agreement
