There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. - 3. On 06/26/2015 Milwaukee police responded to 1201 West National Avenue (Texas Food Mart) for a man with a gun complaint. The applicant stated there was no man with a gun, but he was having trouble with a customer. The applicant told officers a bottle of liquor broke on a counter during a transaction. The customer became upset and started knocking items off of shelves. The customer remained on the scene and a compromise was reached between the applicant and the customer.
- 4. On 08/16/2015 Milwaukee police responded to St. Francis Hospital for a battery complaint. Officers spoke to Roberto Hernandez-Rodriguez who stated the cashier at Texas Food Mart had pushed him. There had been a disagreement while inside the store between Hernandez-Rodriguez, his wife (Eleanore Hernandez) and the cashier at the store (Mohammad Assad). All three parties were cited for disorderly conduct. The citation issued to Assad was dismissed without prejudice while the citation issued to Hernandez-Rodriguez and the citation issued to Hernandez are in warrant status for failure to appear.

- 5. On 01/27/2017 officers were dispatched to 1201 W. National Av to investigate a Strong Armed Robbery complaint. The victims were attacked as they left the business and their property was taken. The business was cooperative and provided surveillance video.
- 6. On 02/14/2017 officers were dispatched to an armed robbery complaint at Texas Foods, 1201 W. National Av. Upon arrival the officers were met by the applicant who directed them to a subject walking away. The subject was stopped and stated it was a dispute over cigarettes. The officers returned to the store and interviewed the applicant. He stated the subject wanted a single cigarette. The applicant refused to sell one to the subject who became upset. At one point the subject made a statement he was going to rob the store. The applicant provided video of the incident.
- 7. On 05/09/2017 at 3:04am officers investigate a burglary that occurred at 1201 W. National Av. The investigation revealed a window was broken and the suspect entered the business. The suspect took money and cigarettes. The incident was captured on video surveillance.




City Concentration Map 1201 W National Ave.

- You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
