This report is written by P.O. Fabian Garcia assigned to District Six, Early Power Shift.

On Wednesday, March 10, 2021, at 2:00 pm I, and my squad partner, P.O. Michael Ward, conducted a CPTED survey at 5928 S. 27th Street.

Upon arrival, I met by the owner Manjinder Kaur and husband Sukhjinder Singh. The business is currently not open for business and is still under construction and did not have any merchandise. Kaur stated they do plan on opening up as soon as their licenses can be approved and are anticipating sometime in April. They do plan on being open Monday through Sunday 8am-9pm.

On the south end of the property they do have a parking lot with lighting though out the exterior of the property. Mr. Singh stated they will be updating the exterior lights with LED lighting. Mr. Singh stated there are currently no cameras throughout the business and will be installing approximately 16 security cameras. Mr. Sing stated they will have two cameras located in the

parking lot, one facing east and one facing west. One camera towards the front of the property facing south. Mr. Singh stated they will have approximately 13 interior cameras. Mr. Singh stated the planned storage capacity for their security surveillance would be one week and only Kaur and Singh will be able to retrieve video surveillance. Mr. Singh stated they do plan on placing "No Loitering" signs as well and are will to be complainants if needed.

Mr. Singh stated that they have participated in the Robbery Prevention Training within 120 days, but was still provided with the Community Outreach and Education phone number.




City Concentration Map 5928 S 27th St Milwaukee

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.


