This report is written by Police Officer David Novak, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 04/01/2011 the applicant was cited for Operating While Intoxicated. He was convicted on 05/04/2011 and his license was revoked for 9 months.
- 2. On 04/18/2020 at 10:49pm officers were dispatched to investigate a possible COVID-19 violation at Juniors Cocktail Lounge, 3300 W. Lincoln Av. The caller stated there were subjects sitting down and drinking alcoholic beverages. When the officer arrived the front door was locked but they looked through the window and observed people sitting at the bar with items in front of them. The officer knocked on the window and the people started putting the items away. The applicant opened the door for the officers and stated the people were waiting for food. the officers advised the applicant no one could wait inside and no liquor could be served. The applicant stated he was unaware of the safer at home orders. The officers explained the order to him and he stated he had no questions. The patrons left without incident.
- 3. On 08/27/2020 officers, along with agents from Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at Junior's Cocktail Lounge, 3300 W. Lincoln Av. Officers observed a security guard at the door checking ID's and monitoring capacity. There were 20 patrons inside, who were wearing masks when not eating, drinking or smoking Hookahs. The agent found the applicant was selling hookah and allowing the smoking of hookah inside without a

license. The Department of Revenue agent seized the hookah and the applicant was issued citations.

- 4. On 09/20/2020 at 11:23pm officers were dispatched to a Noise Nuisance complaint at Junior's Cocktail Lounge, 3300 W. Lincoln Av. The officer did not hear excessive noise coming from the business. The patrons outside stated there was a DJ performing inside and it would end at midnight. The officer did not enter the business because he did not hear any loud music.
- 5. On 12/17/2020 an officer spoke with the manager of the apartment building at 3227 W. Lincoln Av about complaints he has received from his tenants about Junior's Cocktail Lounge at 3300 W. Lincoln Av. The manager stated his tenants complain about the noise level of the patrons as they enter and leave, the use of their parking lot by patrons and the amount of trash left behind. The officers located 15 calls for serve in the past 90 days. The officer advised the manager for the tenant to call with concerns and to possibly testify at a license committee meeting.
- 6. On 03/12/2021 at 1:20am officers were dispatched to a Shots Fired complaint inside Juniors, Cocktail Lounge, 3300 W. Lincoln Av. The officer interviewed the applicant, who was the caller, who stated a subject became upset when the DJ would not play his song. The subject then exited the tavern. A few minutes later a bottle was thrown through a window and a gun shot was fired, shattering the window. Security ran outside and saw the suspect run to a vehicle, which fled the scene. The officers viewed the video system and found the system operating but the camera that would have captured the incident was not functioning.
- 7. On 03/13/2021 at 12:15am officers were dispatched to Shots fired at S. 32st St and W. Lincoln Av. While enroute a second caller stated patrons were running out of the bar and a subject was pointing a gun in a threatening manner. The officer went to Juniors Cocktail Lounge, 3300 W. Lincoln Av. and spoke with security, who stated there was an argument over Hookah. As security was escorting the subject out he was reaching to his waistband as if he had a firearm. Security stated customers were yelling the subject had a gun so he pulled his pistol but he never saw the subject with a weapon. Security was standing outside with his gun drawn watching the subject leave and which is what the callers saw. Inside the tavern the officer observed a DJ booth and found the business does not have a PEP license. The officers viewed video, which confirmed the events as described by security. The officers issued a citation for PEP license required.

TAVERN REPORT

Arnold, Quentin C 029412

This report is being written by Police Officer (P.O.) Quentin C. ARNOLD, assigned to squad 2573, District Two, Late Power Shift partnered with P.O Oscar ESPITIA. We were operating a marked Milwaukee Police Squad car with operating emergency lights and siren. We were equipped with an AXON body worn camera and squad cameras, which captured this investigation.

On Friday, March 12th 2021 at approximately 01:20A.M, my partner and I responded to a shots-fired complaint which occurred within the tavern (Juniors Cocktail Lounge) located at 3300 W. Lincoln Ave, in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Upon our arrival we spoke to the owner CALLOWAY who was also the caller for the shots fired who stated that a (B/M, approximately 30 years of age, 5'06, 230lbs, ear length dreads, wearing a blue and pink sweat suit with the words fruit loops, and white air force ones) became irate when the DJ refused to play his song.

Witnesses on scene stated that the suspect threw his hands up in the air and stormed out of the tavern after the DJ refused to play the song. Within a few minutes of the suspect leaving witnesses observed a bottle being thrown through the south window of the tavern followed by a quishot which shattered the window

Security guards exited the tavern and observed the listed suspect running to his vehicle which was described as a (Black in color, four doors, Chevrolet, Traverse, with unknown auto plates, heavy tint, and alloy rims.

When asked if the cameras were operation at the time of the incident CALLOWAY stated the cameras were working but did not capture the incident. Upon reviewing camera footage all cameras were operational except the camera that would have recorded the event.

This report is typed by PO Oscar ESPITIA assigned to District Two, Late Power Shift and Squad 2573 along with PO ARNOLD.

On Saturday March 13th, 2021 at approximately 12:15 AM, my partner and I, along with Squad 2326 (PO GREER & PO WILKENS), and Squad 2585 (PO BAAS & PO SPINATO) where dispatched to the area between S. 32nd St. and S. 33rd St on Lincoln Ave for a shots fired complaint. Caller stated she heard four gunshots in the area. While enroute a second caller called and stated she observed a subject pointing a gun in a threatening manner and patrons running out of a bar. The only bar in the area is Juniors Cocktail Lounge located at 3300 W. Lincoln Ave.

Upon entering Juniors we spoke with both security guards at the door who were identified as Brandon K. MCDONALD (05/10/85) and Michael G. KOZLOWSKI (W/M,12/18/85) who stated there was an intoxicated patron who smoked out of a hookah without permission and the patron that paid for the hookah. Both subjects got into a verbal argument and security intervene in attempt to deescalate the situation. Security guards stated they asked the intoxicated subject to leave. Security guards continued to state that while the subject was exiting the tavern he reached for his waistband an acted as if he had a firearm.

MCDONALD stated that he observed patrons throw themselves on the ground and screamed that the subject had a gun. MCDONALD stated he pulled his firearm from his holster but never discharged a round because he didn't observe the subject holding a firearm. The subject exited the tavern and walked to his vehicle, a silver newer model Mercedes Benz sedan, 4 door. MCDONALD stated he walked by the front entrance door and told the subject to go home and that the argument was not worth him shooting or fighting anyone. The subject entered the vehicle and MCDONALD told all patrons to get away from the windows in case the subject had a firearm in the vehicle. The subject then drives away last seen Northbound on S. 33rd St.

After the subject drives away MCDONALD exits the tavern holding his firearm and several patrons ran to their vehicles. That was what the second caller observed.

Both security guards possessed valid CCW.

In the rear of the tavern I observed a DJ both and the same DJ we spoke to in the incident that occured the night before and identified himself as Gregory A. MOODY (B/M, 11/04/91). MOODY left the tavern before I could speak with him. Further investigation revealed CALLOWAY doesn't possess a public entertainment license and I file a citation for failure to possess a public entertainment license (CIT#J980XPPTRF).

I spoke to the agent/owner, who was identified as Edward R. CALLOWAY (B/M, 12/28/83). CALLOWAY allowed me to observe surveillance footage of the incident. On the surveillance footage matched with MCDONALD'S story. PO SPINATO downloaded the surveillance footage onto a USB drive. While at District Two the video footage was copied onto a DVD and place in

This report is being written by Police Officer (P.O.) Quentin C. ARNOLD, assigned to District 2 Late Power Shift squad 2557. I was equipped with an AXON body worn camera, which captured this investigation.

On Saturday, April 18th, 2020 at approximately 10:49P.M., (While in full duty Milwaukee Police Uniform operating a marked Milwaukee Police Squad) arrived at Juniors Cocktail Lounge located at 3300 W. Lincoln Ave, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI to investigate a operating non essential business during to COVID-19 pandemic.

An anonymous caller stated that there were subjects inside of the tavern sitting down and, drinking alcoholic beverages. When I attempted to call the caller back I was unable to reach them after multiple attempts.

INTERVIEW OF CALLOWAY

Upon arriving at the tavern the main business door located at the intersection of 3300 W. Lincoln was locked. I looked inside of the taverns windows and observed several subjects sitting at the bar on the north side. When I knocked on the glass they began putting items behind the bar in attempt to clean the area. Eventually a subject opened the door who I identified by Wisconsin Driver License as CALLOWAY, Edward R, B/M, 12/28/1983, 1612 S. 76th Street, C# 414-306-5285. CALLOWAY stated he is the owner of Junior's Cocktail Lounge.

CALLOWAY stated that the subjects were sitting down inside because they were waiting for their food. When asked if he was aware he could not have anyone sitting down inside of the tavern he stated he was unaware of the safer at home orders. I explained to CALLOWAY he was unable to have customers sitting down inside waiting for their food. I then asked CALLOWAY if he was serving liquor inside of the tavern. CALLOWAY at first stated no but, then stated he served somebody a margarita. I informed CALLOWAY that he is not able to operate as a tavern during the order as well.

I asked CALLOWAY if we could resolve the issue by no longer allowing individuals inside the bar to pick up their food. I asked CALLOWAY if it was a possibly if he could have curb side pick up for food and, he complied and stated that he would change his Facebook post to inform his customer base. I informed CALLOWAY that a tavern report will be written about the events that occurred tonight. I also explained the safer at home order again before asking if CALLOWAY had any questions. CALLOWAY stated that I explained everything that he had questions about.

All patrons then left the establishment without incident.

Officers approached the location and observed a security guard outside of the premises who was checking IDs, "wanding" patrons as they entered, and monitoring capacity. Officers observed approximately 20 patrons who were wearing masks when not eating, drinking, or smoking from hookahs, Officers spoke with the licensee, Edward R CALLOWAY, who was on scene and cooperative throughout the investigation. The investigation revealed that CALLOWAY offered for sale and allowed patrons to smoke tobacco products from hookahs inside of the premises (enclosed place) and that CALLOWAY did not possess a license to do so and that the premises did not meet any of the exceptions that would allow for smoking inside of the location. Agent KING did seize 19 units of open and sealed hookah tobacco of various sizes and flavors.

while assigned to Squad 2166, I spoke with Jackie KEMENY (414)737-5933, regarding Junior's Cocktail Lounge, located at 3300 W Lincoln Av. KEMENY is the property manager for an apartment building at 3227 W Lincoln Av and called after receiving on-going complaints from tenants of 3227 W Lincoln Av regarding Junior's Cocktail Lounge. KEMENY stated that tenants have repeatedly complained of the noise level from patrons of Junior's before they enter the location and after they leave. KEMENY stated that patrons of the tavern often park in the parking lot of 3227 W Lincoln Av without permission, leave garbage behind, and drink and/or smoke marijuana in their vehicles.

I asked that KEMENY urge the tenants to place calls to the non-emergency number, contacted their Alderperson, and/or give testimony regarding the premises at a license hearing if one occurs.

I then checked the calls for service to Junior's Cocktail Lounge and found there to be fifteen (15) noise complaints at the location in the past ninety days. The calls were placed between 12:00 am and 2:30 am from mostly one resident in the neighborhood and the calls were either closed with a C15 (officers would often arrive after the patrons had left the area) and a C10 (advised the caller of the disposition). I did speak with the subject who placed the majority of the calls and he stated that he was aware that the license was up for renew in January and planned on giving testimony if he was able to do so.

I attempted to reach the licensee by phone, but received no answer and left a message asking that CALLOWAY return my call.

On Friday, March 12th 2021 at approximately 01:20A.M, my partner and I responded to a shots-fired complaint which occurred within the tavern (Juniors Cocktail Lounge) located at 3300 W. Lincoln Ave, in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Upon our arrival we spoke to the owner CALLOWAY who was also the caller for the shots fired who stated that a (B/M, approximately 30 years of age, 5'06, 230lbs, ear length dreads, wearing a blue and pink sweat suit with the words fruit loops, and white air force ones) became irate when the DJ refused to play his song.

Witnesses on scene stated that the suspect threw his hands up in the air and stormed out of the tavern after the DJ refused to play the song. Within a few minutes of the suspect leaving witnesses observed a bottle being thrown through the south window of the tavern followed by a gunshot which shattered the window

Security guards exited the tavern and observed the listed suspect running to his vehicle which was described as a (Black in color, four doors, Chevrolet, Traverse, with unknown auto plates, heavy tint, and alloy rims.

When asked if the cameras were operation at the time of the incident CALLOWAY stated the cameras were working but did not capture the incident. Upon reviewing camera footage all cameras were operational except the camera that would have recorded the event.

On Saturday March 13th, 2021 at approximately 12:15 AM, my partner and I, along with Squad 2326 (PO GREER & PO WILKENS), and Squad 2585 (PO BAAS & PO SPINATO) where dispatched to the area between S. 32nd St. and S. 33rd St on Lincoln Ave for a shots fired complaint. Caller stated she heard four gunshots in the area. While enroute a second caller called and stated she observed a subject pointing a gun in a threatening manner and patrons running out of a bar. The only bar in the area is Juniors Cocktail Lounge located at 3300 W, Lincoln Ave.

Upon entering Juniors we spoke with both security guards at the door who were identified as Brandon K. MCDONALD (05/10/85) and Michael G. KOZLOWSKI (W/M,12/18/85) who stated there was an intoxicated patron who smoked out of a hookah without permission and the patron that paid for the hookah. Both subjects got into a verbal argument and security intervene in attempt to deescalate the situation. Security guards stated they asked the intoxicated subject to leave. Security guards continued to state that while the subject was exiting the tavern he reached for his waistband an acted as if he had a firearm.

MCDONALD stated that he observed patrons throw themselves on the ground and screamed that the subject had a gun. MCDONALD stated he pulled his firearm from his holster but never discharged a round because he didn't observe the subject holding a firearm. The subject exited the tavern and walked to his vehicle, a silver newer model Mercedes Benz sedan, 4 door. MCDONALD stated he walked by the front entrance door and told the subject to go home and that the argument was not worth him shooting or fighting anyone. The subject entered the vehicle and MCDONALD told all patrons to get away from the windows in case the subject had a firearm in the vehicle. The subject then drives away last seen Northbound on S. 33rd St.

After the subject drives away MCDONALD exits the tavern holding his firearm and several patrons ran to their vehicles. That was what the second caller observed.

Both security guards possessed valid CCW.

In the rear of the tavern I observed a DJ both and the same DJ we spoke to in the incident that occured the riight before and identified himself as Gregory A. MOODY (B/M, 11/04/91). MOODY left the tavern before I could speak with him. Further investigation revealed CALLOWAY doesn't possess a public entertainment license and I file a citation for failure to possess a public entertainment license (CIT#J980XPPTRF).

I spoke to the agent/owner, who was identified as Edward R. CALLOWAY (B/M, 12/28/83). CALLOWAY allowed me to observe surveillance footage of the incident. On the surveillance footage matched with MCDONALD'S story. PO SPINATO downloaded the surveillance footage onto a USB drive.
